Kick-Off

The Saginaw Valley State University Football team travels to Wayne State for a GLIAC contest on Saturday with a 1:00 p.m. (ET) kick off.

The Cardinals had their four-game winning streak snapped in a tightly contested 16-9 loss against Grand Valley State last Saturday, October 19. SVSU took a 9-3 lead into the half, but the Lakers were able to take the lead in the third quarter despite being held to a season-low 50 yards rushing.

Wayne State is coming off a 43-26 loss on the road against Davenport. The Warriors held a 19-12 advantage at halftime, but the Panthers scored 17 points in the third to take the lead for good in the game.

The Series

This is the 44th meeting between Saginaw Valley State and Wayne State. The Cardinals lead the all-time series 32-11-1 and have won the last four meetings, and five of the last six in the series.

Four of the last six meetings have had a one-score deficit; five of the last six finals scores have had a two-score difference, with the average margin of victory during that time being just over eight points.

Last season's overtime win of 17-10 win took place on homecoming week for SVSU. The Cardinals scored before an interception by Eli Gordon sealed the victory.

- The Cardinals currently sit in a tie for second in the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) standings with Davenport. The Cardinals and Panthers are 5-2 overall and 2-1 in league play. Davenport and Saginaw Valley State will meet in two weeks at Harvey Randall Wickes Memorial Stadium.
- SVSU has two games on the road, and two at home in the final four games of the season. The Cardinals are at Wayne State this week before hosting Davenport on 11/2. SVSU then goes to Big Rapids to face Ferris State on the road on 11/9 before wrapping up the regular season against Michigan Tech on 11/16.
- Senior All-American linebacker Micah Cretsinger was named to the East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 and the D2 Elite 100 watch lists. Junior linebacker Brandon Rawls joined Cretsinger on the D2 Elite 100 list.
- Saginaw Valley faces three ranked opponents this season: at (#15) Indianapolis (W, 28-24), (#2) Grand Valley State (L, 16-9), and at (#5) Ferris State on November 9.
- Freshman quarterback Mason McKenzie is 96-of-172 through the air for 1,288 yards and nine touchdowns. McKenzie leads the Cardinals in passing and rushing with 60 carries for 459 yards and four scores on the ground. He currently ranks third in the GLIAC in rushing and passing yards.
- Junior receiver Eric Craft leads the team in receptions with 20 for 325 yards and two scores. Redshirt freshman Joseph Walker has the second-most catches on the team with 16 for 255 yards and a score.
- Terrence Brown Jr. is third on the team with 13 receptions for 197 yards and five total touchdowns (2 rushing, 3 receiving) this season.
- Alfred Dailey Jr. leads the defense with 44 tackles through six games. 2023 All-American linebacker Micah Cretsinger and safety Eli Gordon have 39 stops for second-best on the team. Gordon has a GLIAC-high four interceptions (6th-most in the nation). Leonard Henry IV has 36 stops and leads NCAA Division II in sacks with 8.5 (1.21 per game).
- Brandon Rawls recorded a season-high 11 tackles against Grand Valley State last week. It is the second time this season that Rawls has compiled double-tackles (fourth time of his career).

ABOUT THE WARRIORS

Wayne State is still seeking its first victory of 2024 with an 0-7 start. The Warriors are on a nine-game winless streak dating back to last season. The last win was a 41-17 win over Northern Michigan on October 28, 2023.

Quarterback Champion Edwards leads the team in both passing and rushing. He has 85 carries for 452 yards and one touch-down, along with 64-for-117 passing for 705 yards and five scores.

D'Marco Singleton leads all running backs with 47 carries for 182 yards and a touchdown. Myles McKatherine is Edwards's favorit target with 22 catches for 245 yards and three touchdowns.

Carl Ware is the team's leader on defense with 55 tackles, 8.5 TFLs, and three sacks. He also has one interception, three pass breakups, and a fumble recovery on his stat line. Brayden Vredeveld has 46 tackles. Kaleb Coleman and Elijah Fowlkes tie for third-most stops with 44, while each of them have recovered a fumble as well.

GLIAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior safety Eli Gordon has won GLIAC Football Defensive Player of the Week three times this season. Gordon earned the honor after Cardinal wins over Winona State, Truman State, and Indianapolis. The Midland, Michigan native, leads the SVSU defense in tackles and interceptions. He is sitting third in all of NCAA Division II with an average of 0.7 picks per contest having recorded an interception in four of the first six games this season.

PASS RUSH NIGHTMARE

Cardinal pass rusher Leonard Henry IV has been a nightmare to opposing teams this season. Henry has eight and a half sacks through seven games and has the nation's best sack numbers, averaging 1.21 per game along with a fourth-best 13.5 tackles for loss.

HEAD COACH RYAN BRADY



Ryan Brady enters his fifth season as the head coach of the SVSU football team in 2024. He enters the season with an overall record of 26-18 through four seasons.

The Cardinals had its third-straight winning season under Brady in 2023 with a 6-5 overall mark and a 3-3 record in conference play. Brady coached another dominant defense during his fourth season highlighted by the performance of junior linebacker Micah Cretsinger who tied the NCAA Division II record with four interceptions returned for a touchdown, becoming the first player in the GLIAC to achieve that feat, and only the fifth player in DII history to meet that mark (the last occurrence came in 2011). Cretsinger was also awarded First-Team All-America for his play in 2023. Brady led the Cardinals to its fifth-straight win in the Axe Bowl after defeating rival Northwood 31-8 in week two of the season.

Thirteen players earned All-GLIAC honors in 2023, including running back Terrance Brown Jr., who was named the Freshman of the Year after rushing for 733 yards and six touchdowns in his debut season for SVSU. Derrick Hinton Jr. and Cretsinger received First-Team honors, while Connor Cracchiolo, DJ Summerville, Joe Botello, Alfred Dailey Jr., Brand Rawls, and Brown Jr., were named to the Second-Team. Five others earned honorable mention in Dante Barthwell, Eric Craft, Harold Irby III, Ryan Whitely, and Mikey Woolridge.

During his third season, Brady led the team to an 8-3 record and a 3-3 record in conference play. Highlights included two top-10-ranked wins over the University of Indianapolis and Bowie State in the HBCU Classic Matchup.

During the 2021 season, Brady led the Cardinals to a 7-4 overall record and a 4-3 mark in conference play. Highlights included an Axe Bowl victory over rival Northwood on Homecoming weekend for SVSU. The Cardinals also defeated Texas A&M-Kingsville in the Annual Red Feather Classic game.

SVSU had 17 players earn All-GLIAC honors in 2021. Tommy Scott was the Offensive Back of the Year after leading the conference in rushing yards with 1,044 and ranking second in touchdowns scored with 12. Scott also earned First Team All-GLIAC for the second time in his career. Nick Whiteside was named the GLIAC Defensive Back of the Year and earned First Team All-GLIAC honors. He tied for first in the league in interceptions with four and earned All-GLIAC honors for the second time in his career.

Also earning First Team All-GLIAC for SVSU were wide receiver Casey Williams, kicker Connor Luksic, linebacker Victor Abraham, and offensive linemen Marcellus Anderson. Luksic was named GLIAC Special Teams Player of the Week five times during the 2021 season.

Earning Second Team All-GLIAC on defense were Marvin White, Javaree Jackson, Nathan Talaki, Victor Nelson, and Tim Kidd-Glass. On the offensive side, tight end Isaiah Johnson-Mack earned Second Team All-GLIAC honors as well.

Chad Gailliard, Michael Woolridge, Noah Suber, Trevor Nowaske, and D.J. Summerville were named Honorable Mention All-GLIAC.

There were four Cardinals who earned All-GLIAC First Team honors for SVSU in 2019, including the GLIAC Defensive Lineman of the Year in senior defensive tackle Heath Williams. Senior quarterback Ryan Conklin, junior running back Nate McCrary and junior wideout Chad Gailliard joined Williams on the first team.

Sophomore wide receiver Casey Williams, senior offensive lineman Trevor Curle, and senior linebacker David Still were named All-GLIAC Second Team as well.

Heath Williams would add being named to the D2CCA All-Super Region Three Second Team and he was named to the D2Football.com All-American Second Team. He and Gailliard were both named to the Don Hansen Football Gazette All-Super Region Three Team as well.

Conklin led the GLIAC with 216.3 passing yards per game and 19 touchdowns through the air. McCrary was the first Cardinal to surpass 1,000 yards on the ground since 2013, as he ranked second in the league with his 1,060 yards and 10 touchdowns. Gailliard led the league with his 853 yards receiving and 10 touchdowns. It marked his third straight season leading the GLIAC in receiving yards. Casey Williams was the league leader in receiving yards per game, posting 81.3 yards per contest.

The Saginaw Valley defense ranked fourth in the league after allowing 24.1 points per game and led the way with 15 interceptions during the regular season.

Brady was named the 7th head football coach in the history of Saginaw Valley State University Football on March 21, 2019, and came to Saginaw Valley after serving as the co-defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at Ferris State University.

At Ferris State, Brady has helped lead the Bulldogs to three GLIAC championships and four NCAA Division II Playoff berths in the past five seasons. Ferris State advanced to the national quarterfinals all the past three seasons, semifinals twice, and competed in the 2018 NCAA Division II National Championship game this past fall. FSU compiled three undefeated regular seasons and an overall mark of 75-15 with Brady on staff since the 2012 campaign.

Coach Brady began his tenure with the Bulldogs in the 2012-2013 seasons as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach, helping two-time Harton Hill Award winner Jason Vander Laan to GLIAC Freshman of the Year and All-GLIAC honors. He has spent four of the past five seasons on the defensive side as the Co-defensive coordinator and linebackers coach, leading Ferris State to an overall record of 48-5 with him at the helm of the defense. In the 2016 season, Brady served as the offensive coordinator, offensive line, and tight ends coach, helping lead FSU to the playoffs and a national semifinals appearance.

Brady coached at Grand Rapids Community College from 2009-2011 as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach. The Raiders posted a 30-4 overall record in the three seasons and had the highest scoring offense in the nation all three years.

His collegiate career saw Brady play quarterback at Grand Valley State University, leading the Lakers to a national title game appearance in 2001 and winning a national championship with the 2002 squad. Brady served as the Lakers' quarterbacks coach on their '03 championship squad before going to Muskegon High School as a strength and conditioning coach in 2004. At Muskegon, he served as a student teacher for Tony Annese as well.

He served as the head freshman coach at Chesaning High School in 2005 and then took over as the offensive coordinator and QB coach at Montrose High School in 2006.

He moved on to become head coach at Perry High School in 2008 before joining the staff as quarterbacks coach at Grand Rapids Community College in 2009.

Brady led Chesaning to a state football championship as the school's signal caller in 1998 and was a first-team all-state honoree.

He holds a master's degree in educational leadership from Saginaw Valley State University and a bachelor's degree in professional instruction from Grand Valley State University.
