2012-13 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Home for the Holidays

With less than two weeks until NCAA Division II basketball breaks for the holidays, the last full week of GLVC men's hoops will have a distinct home flavor. Eight of the 12 games scheduled this week will be contested on home floors, including a pair of games in Louisville for No. 5 Bellarmine. The Knights will host the Fern Valley Hotel Classic, which also features No. 7 Southern Indiana. BU will battle UC-Clermont on Friday and Nova Southeastern on Saturday, both at 7:30 p.m. ET. USI will face the exact same opponents on opposite nights at 5 p.m. ET.

Pair of Overtimes Open GLVC Play

While the GLVC posted a 12-2 (.857) non-conference record last week, three exciting GLVC West Division openers stole the headlines. On Wednesday, Maryville (8-1) continued its hot streak with a 72-65 overtime road win at Missouri-St. Louis, a team which was picked by the league coaches to win the GLVC West. The conference dramatics continued on Thursday as Drury's Alex Hall was nearly perfect in the Panthers' 88-52 victory over Missouri S&T, scoring 33 points en route to GLVC Player of the Week honors. On Saturday, Quincy held off an Illinois Springfield second-half rally to defeat the Prairie Stars 78-75 in overtime. The nail biter was nothing new between the two West Division rivals. Last season, the Hawks dropped both matchups with the Prairie Stars by a combined four points. In the 2010-11 season, Quincy came out on top in an overtime game over UIS.

Throwing Up Thirty in GLVC Play

Drury senior Alex Hall and Maryville junior Asa Toney kicked off their respective GLVC seasons in style last week as both conference standouts reached the 30-point mark in wins. Last Wednesday, Toney poured in a career-high 30 points as Maryville posted a thrilling 72-65 overtime victory at Missouri-St. Louis, which marked the Saints first win over the Tritons in 14 attempts. Toney hit 9-of-18 from the field, four 3-pointers and all eight free-throw attempts en route to his 30-point output. Hall netted 33 points in an 88-52 win over Missouri S&T in the conference opener for both schools on Thursday. He hit 12 of 14 shots from the field, including nine of 10 from beyond the arc, which set a new Drury single-game record for three-pointers made in a game.

GLVC Leads Nation With Five Teams Ranked in Top 20

The GLVC tops all NCAA Division II conferences with five men's basketball teams ranked in the latest NABC Division II Top 25 Poll, which was announced on Tuesday. No. 5 Bellarmine and No. 7 Southern Indiana lead a GLVC contingent that includes No. 13 Kentucky Wesleyan, No. 14 Indianapolis and No. 19 Drury. The GLVC's five ranked programs lead the country as the Great Northwest Athletic Conference follows with three teams rated in the top 25. The GLVC is also the only conference with four teams ranked in the top 15 and one of three conferences (GNAC, MIAA) to have a pair of top-10 programs. Additionally, Maryville (8-1) is receiving votes outside the top 25 for the first time this season. Only once last year did the GLVC have five teams in the top 20 as No. 1 Bellarmine, No. 10 Northern Kentucky, No. 13 Southern Indiana, No. 14 Kentucky Wesleyan, and No. 20 Indianapolis were ranked in the Feb. 28, 2012 poll.

A Perfect Way to Start

Entering this week's action, 19 NCAA Division II men's basketball teams owned undefeated records on the year. Five of those 19 squads, or 26.3 percent of the national total, belong to the GLVC. Indianapolis (7-0), Bellarmine (6-0), Drury (6-0), Kentucky Wesleyan (5-0) and Southern Indiana (5-0) have all posted unblemished marks to start the season, making the GLVC the nation's leading conference with undefeated teams. In fact, of the 19 perfect teams, only the MIAA (2-NW Missouri St./Washburn), Northern Sun (2-Augustana/St. Cloud St.) and RMAC (2-Adam St./Metro St.) have multiple unbeaten squads. The remaining eight teams hail from eight different conferences.

Streaking in Style

Seven of the GLVC's 16 basketball teams enter the week having won five or more consecutive victories, while 11 conference teams are building on at least one win. Indianapolis (7), Bellarmine (6), Drury (6), McKendree (6), Kentucky Wesleyan (5), Maryville (5) and Southern Indiana (5) all own a win streak of five or more games, while Lewis (3), Quincy (2), UW-Parkside (2) and Missouri S&T (1) look to build on fairly fresh win streaks this week.

The Nation's Best

In the latest NCAA statistical report, which was released Monday, a pair of GLVC teams and two individuals hold down the No. 1 position in select stat categories. Kentucky Wesleyan paces the country with a 46.2 three-point field goal percentage and Southern Indiana owns a nation's-best rebounding margin of 15.8. Individually, Drury's Alex Hall rates first with a perfect 100 percent free-throw percentage, while teammate Brandon Lockhart leads the country with 4.83 steals per game.

Winning Big

Five GLVC teams are found among the country's top-11 teams in scoring margin. Drury (32.3) and Indianapolis (27.4) rank second and third, respectively, while Kentucky Wesleyan (20.6), UW-Parkside (20.4) and Bellarmine (20.2) rate ninth through 11th in big wins.

Hot Shooting Continues

In addition to winning big, GLVC squads are also putting on a shooting clinic this year as nearly half of the entire conference is found among the nation's top 20 in field-goal percentage. Seven league teams have made at least 49 percent of their shots this season, including No. 2 Kentucky Wesleyan (54.4), No. 5 Indianapolis (52.9), No. 7 Bellarmine (52.4), No. 11 Drury (50.9), No. 16 Southern Indiana (50.2), No. 18 Lewis (49.8) and No. 20 UW-Parkside (49.7).

Taking Care of the Ball

Four GLVC teams currently rank among the nation's top 20 teams in assist turnover ratio, including No. 2 UW-Parkside (1.76), No. 6 Indianapolis (1.59), No. 9 Drury (1.49), and No. 19 Lewis (1.33). Individually, Lewis' David Bryant (6.33) ranks third, UW-Parkside's Andy Mazurcak (3.83) and Bryant Smith (3.63) are 12th and 17th, respectively, Ulndy's Reece Cheatham (3.57) is 19th, and Drury's Drake Patterson (3.00) is 21st.

GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Drury University senior guard Alex Hall has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, it was announced by the conference office on Monday. Hall helped improve Drury to 6-0 on the season with a record-breaking shooting performance en route to 33 points in an 88-52 win over Missouri S&T in the conference opener for both schools on Thursday.

Hall hit 12 of 14 shots from the field, including nine of 10 from beyond the arc, which set a new Drury single-game record for three-pointers made in a game. The Springfield, Mo., native completed the night shooting 86 percent from the field and 90 percent from the perimeter. His stat line also included three steals, two rebounds, an assist and a block.

A first-team All-GLVC selection last year, Hall currently ranks tied for first in the conference in scoring with 21.0 points per game. He sits fifth in the league in three-point percentage at .568, having made 25 of his 44 attempts on the year.

This is the second career weekly honor for Hall, who was first recognized by the league on Nov. 23, 2009.

Drury is now idle until a Dec. 15 game at Wayne State in Detroit, Mich.
