**2012-13 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES**

**Fast Break to Winter Break**

A shortened three-day week of GLVC men's basketball tipped off Monday night with four conference teams in action. Kentucky Wesleyan defeated Union (Tenn.) 84-73, Maryville stopped Missouri Baptist 86-54, and Missouri-St. Louis captured an 81-65 victory on the road at Lincoln. In other action, Saint Joseph's fell 89-75 to Trinity Christian. On Tuesday, 14th-ranked Drury dropped its first loss of the season with a 72-69 defeat to No. 5 and defending NCAA Champion Western Washington in Las Vegas. Also in action Tuesday was Quincy, which fell 76-50 to future GLVC foe Truman State -- a team the Hawks beat 62-60 back on Nov. 20. Seven games are on the docket for Wednesday before the GLVC and Division II breaks until Dec. 29 for the holidays.

**GLVC Breaking for the Holidays**

In addition to GLVC men's basketball teams breaking for the holidays, the GLVC office will also be adjusting its weekly coverage over the winter intermission. Next week's Player of the Week award, which typically is announced on Monday, will be moved up to late this week in observance of Christmas Eve. With this week's action concluding on Wednesday, the GLVC will honor the next Player of the Week on Thursday, Dec. 20. Player of the Week selections will resume on Monday, Dec. 31. The GLVC weekly release will resume on Tuesday, Jan. 1, previewing the conference openers for several GLVC schools on Thursday, Jan. 3. The NABC Division II Coaches Poll, which was released on Tuesday, will not be issued until Tuesday, Jan. 8.

**Taking a Look Back**

The GLVC scored a 7-5 combined record last week over a 12-game slate that was highlighted by Drury's 82-78 in-region road win at Wayne State, while Bellarmine defended its home court with a 2-0 mark in the Knights' Fern Valley Classic.

**GLVC Leads Nation With Five Teams Ranked in Top 20**

The GLVC tops all NCAA Division II conferences with five men's basketball teams ranked in the latest NABC Division II Top 25 Poll, which was announced on Tuesday. No. 4 Bellarmine and No. 9 Kentucky Wesleyan lead a GLVC contingent that includes No. 11 Indianapolis, No. 14 Drury, and No. 17 Southern Indiana. This marks the second straight week the GLVC has paced the nation with five teams in the top 20 as Bellarmine was fifth, Southern Indiana was seventh, Kentucky Wesleyan was 13th, Indianapolis was 14th, and Drury was 19th. Only once last year did the GLVC have five teams in the top 20 as No. 1 Bellarmine, No. 10 Northern Kentucky, No. 13 Southern Indiana, No. 14 Kentucky Wesleyan, and No. 20 Indianapolis were ranked in the Feb. 28, 2012 poll.

**In-Season Streiking**

Ten of the 16 conference teams enter Wednesday's action with win streaks of at least one game. Bellarmine leads the way with eight straight wins, followed by Indianapolis (7), Kentucky Wesleyan (7), Lewis (3), UW-Parkside (2), Maryville (1), Southern Indiana (1), Missouri-St. Louis (1), William Jewell (1), and Missouri S&T (1).

**A Perfect Way to Start**

Entering Wednesday's action, 12 NCAA Division II men's basketball teams owned undefeated records on the year. Three of those 12, or 25 percent of the national total, belong to the GLVC. Bellarmine (8-0), Indianapolis (7-0) and Kentucky Wesleyan (7-0) have all posted unblemished marks to start the season, making the GLVC the nation's leading conference with undefeated teams. Last week, the GLVC owned five of the 19 undefeated teams in the country.

**The Nation's Best**

In the latest NCAA statistical report, which was released Monday, a trio of GLVC teams and three individuals hold down the No. 1 position in select stat categories. Kentucky Wesleyan paces the country with 55.4 field-goal and 46.2 three-point field goal percentages, while Southern Indiana owns a nation's-best rebounding margin of 15.9. Individually, Drury's Alex Hall rates first with a perfect 100 percent free-throw percentage, while teammate Brandon Lockhart leads the country with 8.1 assists per game. Lewis' David Bryant also paces the nation with a 6.33 assist-turnover ratio. Additionally, three teams and two GLVC players rank second nationally in their respective categories, which can be found on page two.

**Winning Big**

Six GLVC teams are found among the country's top-15 teams in scoring margin. Drury (28.3) and Indianapolis (27.4) rank second and third, respectively, while Bellarmine (22.6), Kentucky Wesleyan (20.6), and UW-Parkside (20.4) rank sixth through eighth in big wins. William Jewell (17.6) rounds out the conference contingent in 15th.

**Hot Shooting Continues**

In addition to winning big, GLVC squads are also putting on a shooting clinic this year as nearly half of the entire conference is found among the nation's top 20 in field-goal percentage. Seven league teams have made at least 49 percent of their shots this season, including No. 1 Kentucky Wesleyan (55.4), No. 5 Indianapolis (52.9), No. 6 Bellarmine (52.7), No. 9 Southern Indiana (51.6), No. 11 Drury (50.8), No. 16 Lewis (49.8) and No. 19 UW-Parkside (49.7).

**Lockhart Lockdown**

Drury's Brandon Lockhart is off to an impressive start in his senior season as he currently leads the nation with 8.1 assists per game and rates second in the country with 4.29 steals per game. The talented Panther leads the GLVC in both respective categories and has contributed several of the league's highs in assists and steals. On three occasions, Lockhart has dished 10 or more assists, including a conference-best 12 against Arkansas Tech on Nov. 24 and 10, which occurred last Saturday in a road win at Wayne State. He has also recorded five steals in five different games this year, and has posted six thefts on two occasions.

**GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

Bellarmine University senior guard Chris Dowe has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, it was announced by the conference office on Monday. Dowe helped the fifth-ranked Knights to a 2-0 record at their own Fern Valley Classic last week by averaging 18.5 points on 57.1 percent shooting, 4.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists.

In Friday's game, Dowe was one of four Knights in double figures with 12 points and three assists, while adding a spark defensively with five defensive rebounds, three blocked shots and a steal as BU contained UC Clermont 90-57.

The Louisville, Ky., native then responded with an impressive 25-point effort on 64.3 percent shooting to lead the Knights past Nova Southeastern 75-48 on Saturday to keep Bellarmine a perfect 8-0 on the season. Dowe scored 11 of the Knights' 26 first-half points and was then perfect on five of his six attempts in the final 20 minutes to secure the win. He also brought the crowd at Knights Hall to its feet in a 45-second barrage that included two dunks, two steals, and a three-pointer. In addition to his 25 points, Dowe recorded six assists, three rebounds, and two steals in the win.

This is Dowe's first weekly honor of his career and the first Player of the Week nod for Bellarmine since Vance Hall was recognized by the conference earlier this year on Nov. 19.

The Knights now get a long break before heading into GLVC play with a home contest against Quincy on Jan. 3.
