2012-13 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Conference Season Opens This Week

It's the first full week of December and we are already opening up the conference slate! Three GLVC games are on the docket this week, including Maryville traveling to Missouri-St. Louis on Wednesday, Missouri S&T at Drury on Thursday, and Illinois Springfield at Quincy on Saturday. The three league games are the only conference matchups that will take place prior to winter break. A full slate of GLVC contests begin on Jan. 3. In all 17 games will be contested this week, while the first two came on Tuesday with McKendree doubling-up Principia 92-46 and UW-Parkside topping Northland International, 82-44.

A Look Back at Last Week

Of the 19 games contested last week, the GLVC posted an impressive 15-4 (.789) record -- its best non-conference performance of the year. In the 15 wins, GLVC teams won by an average margin of victory of 20.2 points, while the league's four losses were by an average of 9.0 points. Three teams -- Bellarmine, Drury, and Indianapolis -- went undefeated on the week to maintain their unblemished marks. Uindy paces the conference with a 6-0 mark, while Bellarmine and Drury are each 5-0. Kentucky Wesleyan and Southern Indiana, two teams that were idle last week, are also undefeated on the year with 4-0 records each.

Winning Start

The GLVC is off to a winning start this season, capturing 58 of 88 games for a .659 winning percentage. East Division teams have combined for a 31-10 record, while West Division squads sit a combined 27-20.

Four Teams Ranked Among Nation's Top 20

Four GLVC teams have been ranked among the nation's top 20 squads in the latest National Association of Basketball Coaches Division II Top 25 Poll, which was announced on Tuesday. Bellarmine and Southern Indiana hold down top-10 rankings as the Knights are fifth overall followed by the Screaming Eagles in seventh. Kentucky Wesleyan and Indianapolis are 16th and 17th, respectively, while Drury and Missouri-St. Louis are receiving votes outside the top 25.

GLVC Boasts Nation's Best Statistical Teams & Standouts

The GLVC boasts several team and individuals ranked among the nation's best in select statistical categories as was released by the NCAA on Tuesday. Kentucky Wesleyan (56.0) and Lewis (8.5) top the country in field-goal percentage and turnovers per game, respectively, while Drury's Alex Hall and Southern Indiana's Lawrence Thomas are first with a perfect free-throw percentage (100.0). Additionally, Drury (31.6) and Indianapolis (31.3) ranked Nos. 2-3 in scoring margin, Indianapolis (55.2) is second in field-goal percentage, Southern Indiana (15.0) is second in rebounding margin, and Drury (23.6) is second in assists per game. The 90s Are In Again

While a pair of 100-point games made the headlines two weeks back, the GLVC showed yet again its ability to put points on the board with four squads scoring more than 90 points in five wins last week. Indianapolis recorded 92 points in a victory over IU Kokomo last Wednesday only to follow it with 94 points in a win over Cincinnati Christian on Friday. The night before, Saint Joseph's put up 95 points against Holy Cross. On Saturday, Drury scored 98 points against Central Christian, while William Jewell recorded 98 points in a win over Central Christian College of the Bible. The 98 points accounted for the third-highest point total in the league thus far.

McKendree Making the Most of First Year

McKendree has certainly been making the most of its first year in the league as the Bearcats are the only GLVC team to boast two standouts among the conference's top-10 scorers. Junior Clinton Happe ranks second with 19.7 points per game, while senior John Steppe, the current GLVC Player of the Week, is seventh at 17.3. Much of the scoring has come from minimal rest as Mck also has four players ranked in the GLVC's top 10 in minutes played. Happe leads the conference at 38.00 minutes per game, while Steppe (33.00), sophomore Mike DiGregorio (32.50) and freshman Matt Murphy (31.67) rank sixth through eighth, respectively.

Taking Care of the Ball

Four GLVC teams currently rank among the nation's top 15 teams in assist turnover ratio, including No. 3 UW-Parkside (1.74), No. 4 Indianapolis (1.74), No. 9 Lewis (1.53), and No. 15 Drury (1.46). Individually, UW-Parkside's Andy Mazurcak (5.33) ranks sixth and Uindy's Reece Cheatham (4.4) is 10th. Cheatham turned in an impressive performance last week as he recorded 12 assists to just one miscue in a pair of wins.

Three's A Crowd

Speaking of assists, three GLVC standouts have become quite fond of one another in the conference rankings in both assists and steals. Drury's Brandon Lockhart (7.40), Kentucky Wesleyan's Lucas Barker (6.25), and Southern Indiana's Lawrence Thomas (4.75) rank first, second and fifth, respectively, in conference assists, while the trio is 1-2-3 in conference steals. Lockhart leads the way with 4.80 thefts per game, followed by Barker (3.00) and Thomas (2.50).

Panthers Putting on Shooting Clinic

With Kentucky Wesleyan's Lucas Barker ranked near the top of the conference in assists, four other Panthers are among the league's top shooters so far this season. In fact, four KWC players rank in the GLVC's top eight in field-goal percentage, led by No. 1 Dazmond Starke (.720). Junior Donovan Johnson (.645) rates fifth, followed by junior Dominique Dawson (.632) and junior Rico Ferguson (.619) in seventh and eighth, respectively. KWC is also one of four GLVC teams shooting above 50 percent on the year, ranking first at .560. Uindy sits second at .553, while Bellarmine and Drury are third and fourth with a rounded shooting percentage of .505.

GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

McKendree University senior guard John Steppe has been selected as the Great Lakes Valley Conference Player of the Week in men's basketball, it was announced by the league office on Monday. In guiding the Bearcats to a 2-0 record this past week, Lockhart averaged 19.5 points, 8.5 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 1.0 steals per game.

In McKendree's 69-53 victory over Lincoln Christian on Tuesday, Steppe registered his second career double-double, both of which have come this season, with 22 points and a career-high 13 rebounds. The Effingham, Ill., native also tallied three assists and two steals in the win.

The Bearcats' senior co-captain then helped lead the Bearcats to a come-from-behind 80-70 win over Trevecca Nazarene on Saturday, which extended McK's win streak to three games. He had 17 points and six assists to go along with four rebounds.

With the victory, Steppe was able to move into the top 40 on the Bearcats' all-time scoring chart, ending this past week with 1,067 career points.

This is the first weekly honor for a McKendree basketball player.

Steppe currently rates seventh-best in the GLVC with 17.3 points per game, and is fourth in rebounds with 7.3 caroms each time out.
