2012-13 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Last of GLVC's Unbeatens Battle Thursday

Two Great Lakes Valley Conference men's basketball teams enter the third week of January still undefeated for the season. This Thursday, only one of those teams will remain unbeaten. GLVC action is highlighted this week with No. 5 Indianapolis (12-0, 4-0 GLVC) traveling to No. 4 Kentucky Wesleyan (12-0, 4-0) on Thursday.

Taking a Look Back

GLVC men's basketball closed out two weeks of cross-divisional play in thrilling fashion last Saturday as Maryville gave No. 4 Bellarmine its second-straight upset loss. The Saints captured a 69-64 victory, while No. 6 Kentucky Wesleyan, No. 7 Indianapolis, and UW-Parkside defeated West Division teams to stay perfect at 4-0 in conference play. In last week's opener on Thursday, two top-10 teams fell to cross-divisional league opponents. Missouri-St. Louis upended No. 4 Bellarmine 87-82 in double-overtime, while Illinois Springfield upset No. 10 Southern Indiana, 73-71. UMSL's win marked the first double-overtime contest in conference play since UMSL defeated Maryville 72-61 on Feb. 17, 2011.

A Case of the Mondays

With several schools taking the day off for Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Day on Monday, Jan. 21, 10 GLVC teams will take to the court in divisional play for the rare Monday matchups. Rockhurst heads to William Jewell, UIndy travels to Saint Joseph's, Lewis hits the road to UW-Parkside, Southern Indiana crosses the river to Kentucky Wesleyan, and Bellarmine plays at McKendree.

A Perfect Way to Start

Entering this week's action, just four NCAA Division II men's basketball teams own undefeated records on the year, with Indianapolis (12-0) and Kentucky Wesleyan (12-0) among the group. While Bellarmine was the latest GLVC team to fall from the ranks of the unbeaten, top-ranked West Liberty was upset Monday at the University of Charleston. Metro State (13-0) and Western Washington (14-0) are the other two unbeaten squads.

There's a First...

At 12-0 each, Indianapolis and Kentucky Wesleyan have done what no GLVC team has done in recent history. The pair of GLVC leaders enter the third week of conference play with unblemished overall marks, which has not been done in at least the last eight years. Last season, Kentucky Wesleyan (12-0) and Northern Kentucky (12-0) made it to the second week of the 2011-12 season unbeaten, but neither team survived the third full week of conference play. One team will for sure end Thursday with a loss as UIndy and Kentucky Wesleyan square off in Owensboro, Ky. The Greyounds then travel to No. 15 Southern Indiana on Saturday, while the Panthers host Saint Joseph's.

GLVC Boasts Four Teams in Nation's Top 10

The GLVC continues to top all NCAA Division II conferences with four men's basketball teams ranked in the latest National Association of Basketball Coaches Division II Top 25 Poll, which was announced on Tuesday. No. 4 Kentucky Wesleyan and No. 5 Indianapolis give the GLVC its first top-five tandem since KWC and Bellarmine were ranked first and second, respectively, in the Jan. 17, 2012 poll. Also ranked this week is No. 12 Bellarmine and No. 15 Southern Indiana.

The Nation's Best

In the latest NCAA statistical report, which was released Jan. 13, several teams and individuals rank among the nation's best in select stat categories. Six teams -- No. 3 Indianapolis (20.8), No. 7 Bellarmine (17.9), No. 8 Kentucky Wesleyan (17.7), No. 9 Drury (17.5), No. 12 Southern Indiana (15.0), and No. 13 UW-Parkside (14.9) -- rank among the nation's top 15 in scoring margin. Bellarmine (52.2), UIndy (51.9), and Kentucky Wesleyan (51.8) rank fourth, sixth and eighth, respectively, in field-goal percentage, while USI (13.3) is third in rebounding margin and UIndy (1.51) is fourth in assist-turnover ratio. A complete breakdown of where the GLVC ranks among the NCAA's top 25 stat leaders can be found on page two of the weekly release.

Coming Up Clutch in Upset - Part I

Illinois Springfield senior guard Kyle Gupton posted impressive -- and clutch -- numbers in the Prairie Stars' 73-71 upset over then-No. 10 Southern Indiana on Thursday. He scored a career high of 26 points on 10-of-17 shooting, including 6-of-9 from beyond the arc. Gupton scored nine of his 26 points in the final five minutes of regulation to help secure the win. His clutch perimeter shooting also kept UIS in the running for a second upset over No. 6 Kentucky Wesleyan, before falling 74-61 on Saturday. For the week, Gupton was 17-of-28 (.607) from the field and 10-of-16 (.625) beyond the arc.

Coming Up Clutch in Upset - Part II

Missouri-St. Louis senior guard Joshua McCoy rallied the Tritons to a pair of conference wins last week, their first GLVC victories of the season. In nothing that first win, McCoy came up clutch in the 87-82 double-overtime upset over then-No. 4 Bellarmine. He scored 28 points, including a stretch of 16 straight for UMSL, with 11 of those coming in the final 3:26 of regulation to help force overtime. He then scored the first five points of the first OT during a span in which he was 5-of-5 from the field, including 2-of-2 from three-point range and 4-of-4 at the free-throw line. McCoy also finished the game with seven rebounds, six assists and four steals. On the week, McCoy went 13-of-13 at the free-throw line.

Clutch or Common Practice?

While UMSL's Joshua McCoy was a clutch 13-of-13 from the free-throw line last week, that effort has become common practice this year for the Tritons, who are the top-rated free-throw shooting squad in the country right now at 81.8 percent. In addition, McCoy's teammate Charlie Woods leads the nation with a percentage of 97.4 from the stripe, while UMSL's Michael Weber is fourth at 94.1. Also of note, Drury's Alex Hall ranks just ahead of Weber in third at 95.3, while No. 10 UW-Parkside (76.5), No. 12 Quincy (76.2) and No. 21 Rockhurst (75.2) are among the nation's top-25 teams in free-throw percentage.

Starke, Barker Pacing Panthers and GLVC

A big reason Kentucky Wesleyan is off to a 12-0 start this season is the big 6-foot-7 senior center Dazmond Starke. But don't discount the efforts of 6-0 freshman guard Lucas Barker either. Starke leads the country in field-goal percentage (71.0), paces the GLVC in rebounding (9.0), and is 14th in the league in scoring (14.8). Barker, meanwhile, has been filling the stat sheet and is coming off a week where he averaged 19.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 3.0 steals in 38.5 minutes of play. He is second in the GLVC in assists (5.50) and steals (2.33), ninth in assist-turnover ratio (3.4), 18th in points (13.9) and 24th in rebounds (5.1) per game.

GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Maryville University sophomore guard Armon Provo has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, after coming up clutch in a pair of Saints' cross-divisional conference wins last week, including an upset over No. 4 Bellarmine.

Against McKendree on Thursday, Maryville was holding a one-point lead with 12 seconds left when Provo drained a three-pointer at the shot clock buzzer to help ensure the victory, 72-69. He finished with 16 points on 5-of-8 shooting and added six assists, three rebounds, two steals and a block without committing a turnover.

Holding a one-point lead over No. 4 Bellarmine on Saturday, Provo hit another crucial three-pointer with 7.1 seconds left to help secure the Saints' 69-64 victory, which was the program's first-ever win over a ranked opponent. Provo scored a game-high 19 points on 8-of-15 shooting, adding three assists, two rebounds and a steal in the win.

For the week, the Oklahoma City, Okla., native averaged 17.5 points on 56.5 percent shooting, 4.5 assists, 2.5 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game, all while committing zero turnovers.

This is the first weekly honor of Provo's career and the first for a Maryville standout since teammate Asa Toney was recognized by the league on Dec. 20, 2012.

Maryville (13-4, 3-2 GLVC) hits the road this week with games against William Jewell on Thursday and Rockhurst on Saturday.
