**2012-13 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES**

**No. 15 Southern Indiana Stuns No. 4 KWC to Open Week**  
GLVC men's basketball opened the week with a bang on Monday as No. 15 Southern Indiana marched into No. 4 Kentucky Wesleyan and knocked the Panthers from the ranks of the unbeaten with a 72-53 upset win. The Screaming Eagles are now 3-0 in division play and have tied KWC for the lead in the East with a 6-1 GLVC mark. Bellarmine and Indianapolis were both winners Monday night to move into a tie at 5-2 with UW-Parkside, which fell at home to Lewis. In the lone GLVC West matchup on Monday, William Jewell topped Rockhurst improve to third in the West at 4-3. Eight GLVC games are on the docket for both Thursday and Saturday. Thursday's headliner features co-GLVC West Division leaders Drury (11-4, 5-2 GLVC) and Maryville (15-4, 5-2) battling in St. Louis, while Saturday's action is showcased by No. 8 Bellarmine (13-2, 5-2) visiting No. 11 Indianapolis (13-2, 5-2).

**Taking a Look Back**

In a week that started out with three undefeated teams in conference play, ended with just one -- Kentucky Wesleyan -- which went on to suffer its first GLVC loss on Monday. The Panthers handed previously-unbeaten UIndy its first league loss of the year, while No. 12 Bellarmine put a stop to UW-Parkside's four-game conference winning streak in a 65-58 contest on Thursday. In the West Division, William Jewell topped preseason division favorite Missouri-St. Louis, 79-71, on Saturday.

**GLVC Boasts Four Teams in Nation's Top 15**

The GLVC leads the nation once again with four men's basketball teams ranked in the latest National Association of Basketball Coaches Division II Top 25 Poll, which was announced on Tuesday. No. 3 Kentucky Wesleyan paces a conference contingent that includes No. 8 Bellarmine, No. 10 Southern Indiana, and No. 11 Indianapolis. This week marks the fifth consecutive poll the GLVC has boasted four teams in the nation's top 15, and just the second week the conference has claimed three teams in the top 10.

**The Nation's Best**

In the latest NCAA statistical report, which was released Jan. 20, several teams and individuals rank among the nation's best in select stat categories. Six teams -- No. 4 Kentucky Wesleyan (18.3), No. 6 Drury (17.9), No. 10 Bellarmine (16.1), No. 10 Indianapolis (16.1), No. 13 Southern Indiana (14.5), and No. 17 UW-Parkside (13.5) -- rank among the nation's top 20 in scoring margin. Missouri-St. Louis (80.4) tops the country in free-throw percentage, KWC's Dazmond Starke (69.7) ranks first in field-goal percentage, Southern Indiana (13.4) is second in rebounding, as is UMSL's Michael Weber (94.1) in free-throw percentage. A complete breakdown of where the GLVC ranks among the NCAA's top 25 stat leaders can be found on page two of the weekly release.

**Back to the 90s**

Only one GLVC team -- Drury (82.4) -- is currently averaging more than 77 points per outing in conference games only, yet three league squads eclipsed the 90-point mark in wins last week. Kentucky Wesleyan posted 92 points against Saint Joseph's on Saturday, which is the most scored in a GLVC game this year. On Thursday, Drury and Southern Indiana netted 90 points each against Illinois Springfield and Saint Joseph's, respectively.

**Perimeter Pumas**

While Saint Joseph's may have allowed those 90-point contests last week, the Pumas paced the conference in three-point shooting. In the loss to Southern Indiana on Thursday, Saint Joseph's posted 16 buckets from beyond the arc, good for a season high in the conference this year. In fact, the 16 treys were the most by a league team since Maryville netted 18 against Missouri-St. Louis on Jan. 2, 2010. The Pumas' 36 attempts against the Screaming Eagles were the second-most taken in the GLVC this year.

**Busy on the Boards**

Including its 72-53 win over then-No. 4 Kentucky Wesleyan on Monday, Southern Indiana proved to be busy on the boards this past week, notching the top-three rebounding totals in the league. USI grabbed a GLVC-only season-high 53 caroms against Saint Joseph's, only to follow with 45 boards in the win over Indianapolis on Saturday. The Screaming Eagles then pulled down 39 boards in the win over KWC. In conference games only this year, USI owns the top-three rebounding totals.

**Drury Dishing Dimes**

With Southern Indiana busy on the boards, Drury has been pacing the GLVC and ranking among one of the best in the country in assists. Just this past week, the Panthers notched the GLVC's top two assists totals this season, with 27 dimes against Illinois Springfield on Thursday and 29 helpers against Quincy on Saturday. The Panthers currently rank fourth in the nation with 20.2 assists per game, while Brandon Lockhart is 10th overall with 6.4 assists each time out.

**Saffold Not Folding Under Pressure**

So far this season, UW-Parkside's Jeremy Saffold is simply following the lead of the conference's top scorers of yesterday. Saffold currently paces the GLVC in overall scoring (20.0 ppg in 15 games) and in conference play (18.8 in 6 games). In recent years, it has not been uncommon for the conference's top scorer to own the lead in both categories. Last year, Kentucky Wesleyan's Anthony Young averaged 19.7 points in both 18 league games and 31 overall contests. In 2010-11, UIndy's Darius Adams scored 24.3 points in conference play and 23.2 points overall. USI's Jamar Smith led the conference in 2009-10 with 21.2 points in 17 games, while scoring 21.6 points in 26 overall outings. The year before that, UW-Parkside's LaVontay Fenderson recorded 25.3 points in 18 GLVC contests and 26.3 points in 27 contests. A scoring split has not occurred since the 2007-08 season when Kentucky Wesleyan's Jeff Fahnbulleh averaged 20.6 points in GLVC action, while USI's Norman Plummer paced the league with 19.5 points in 27 games.

**Flyers Soaring in Scoring**

Including Monday's five conference games, a total of 21 contests were played in the last week. Of those 21 games, three different Lewis standouts in three different outings registered the top-three shooting performances among GLVC players. Julian Lewis (.800) recorded the league's top shooting effort of last week with an 8-of-10 performance at McKendree last Thursday. On Saturday, David Bryant (.667) was 8-of-12 shooting at Bellarmine, good for third overall, while Ryan Jackson (.769) was an impressive 10-of-13 shooting on Monday night at UW-Parkside, which ranked second on the week.

**GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

University of Southern Indiana junior forward Aaron Nelson has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, after averaging a double-double as the Screaming Eagles completed a homestand sweep, including a win over fifth-ranked Indianapolis.

Nelson opened the week with a 15-point, 11-rebound performance against Saint Joseph's, helping the Eagles to a 90-81 victory. He shot 54.5 percent (6-of-11) from the field and was 50 percent (3-of-6) from beyond the arc.

The Chicago Heights, Ill., native finished the week with a double-double, 10 points and 10 rebounds, in the 69-55 win over nationally-ranked UIndy. He shot 60 percent from the field and was a perfect 4-of-4 from the charity stripe, while grabbing 10 defensive rebounds.

For the week, Nelson averaged 12.5 points and 10.5 rebounds. He shot 56.3 percent from the field (9-of-16) and 70 percent from the stripe (7-of-10), while snagging a total of 21 rebounds, including 16 on the defensive end.

Nelson is averaging 12.1 points and 8.2 rebounds per game this season.

This is the first weekly honor of Nelson's career and the first for an Eagle since teammate Orlando Rutledge was recognized by the league on Dec. 31, 2012.
