2012-13 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

GLVC Basketball Halfway Home

With nine games down and nine remaining, the GLVC men's basketball season is set to close out the month of January and storm into the final full month of the regular season this week. Thursday's matchups are headlined by another top-25 battle with No. 6 Bellarmine (15-2, 7-2 GLVC) visiting No. 13 Southern Indiana (14-3, 7-2) for potential sole control of the GLVC East Division. The Knights will remain in the spotlight on Saturday as Bellarmine hosts rival No. 18 Kentucky Wesleyan (14-3, 6-3). Elsewhere in the East, UW-Parkside (12-5, 7-2), which is tied with Bellarmine and Southern Indiana for the division lead, travels to Saint Joseph's (5-11, 3-6) on Thursday before returning home on Saturday to face No. 15 Indianapolis (14-3, 6-3). Drury (13-4, 7-2) owns a one-game advantage over Maryville (16-5, 6-3) in the GLVC West standings, and travels to William Jewell (8-9, 4-5) and Rockhurst (3-13, 2-7) this week.

Taking a Look Back

As we are set to begin the final half of the GLVC season, the race for the division titles have thickened, thanks in large part to the wild week that was this past week. The madness began when then-No. 15 Southern Indiana knocked rival and then-No. 4 Kentucky Wesleyan from the ranks of the unbeaten. After the new polls were issued Tuesday, No. 10 USI fell 77-68 at UW-Parkside on Thursday, while No. 3 KWC lost 75-71 at Lewis. Elsewhere, No. 11 Indianapolis hit the century mark in a win over McKendree, Rockhurst earned its first GLVC win of the year, Drury more than doubled-up its fellow co-West Division leader Maryville, while Illinois Springfield held on to defeat William Jewell 87-84 in triple overtime. At the end of the night, five teams sat tied for the East Division lead at 6-2. On Saturday, No. 8 Bellarmine scored a 77-68 road win at No. 11 Indianapolis and UW-Parkside stunned No. 3 Kentucky Wesleyan, 60-59, sending the Panthers to their third-straight conference loss of the week.

GLVC Boasts Four Teams in Nation's Top 25

The GLVC leads the nation once again with four men's basketball teams ranked in the latest National Association of Basketball Coaches Division II Top 25 Poll, which was announced on Tuesday. No. 6 Bellarmine leads all GLVC squads, followed by No. 13 Southern Indiana, No. 15 Indianapolis, and No. 18 Kentucky Wesleyan.

The Nation's Best

In the latest NCAA statistical report, which was released Jan. 27, several teams and individuals rank among the nation's best in select stat categories. Six teams -- No. 4 Drury (18.4), No. 7 Bellarmine (15.5), No. 8 Indianapolis (15.4), No. 14 Kentucky Wesleyan (13.6), No. 17 Southern Indiana (12.6), and No. 22 UW-Parkside (11.5) -- rank among the nation's top 25 in scoring margin. Missouri-St. Louis (80.5) tops the country in free-throw percentage as does UMSL's Michael Weber (95.2), while KWC's Dazmond Starke (66.7) ranks second in field-goal percentage and UW-Parkside's Andy Mazurczak (3.40) is second in assist-turnover ratio. A complete breakdown of where the GLVC ranks among the NCAA's top 25 stat leaders can be found on page two of the weekly release.

Drury Divisional Double-Up

Halfway through the conference season, GLVC West Division leader Drury paces the league with a +18.2 scoring margin in nine GLVC games. The Panthers are averaging 81.0 points per game, while allowing just 62.8 points each time out. Bellarmine, the East Division tri-leader, ranks second in the category, but it's a distant second. The Knights boast a +9.2 scoring margin in conference-only games, nearly half the total the Panthers have posted in the first half of the season. In addition to scoring margin, Drury has also doubled-up the second-best conference team this year in turnover margin. The Panthers have a +5.89 turnover margin in nine conference games, while East Division tri-leader UW-Parkside is second at +2.89.

Jackson 5

Nine games into the conference season, UW-Parkside senior Jeremy Saffold leads the league in scoring with 19.0 points -- one of nine upperclassmen found among the top-10 scorers in the GLVC. The lone underclassman is Lewis sophomore Ryan Jackson, who rates fifth overall at 16.9 points per game. In last Monday's win over UWP, Jackson outscored Saffold 32-22, while netting 10 of his 13 shots.

UIS Stars in Triple Overtime

Illinois Springfield outlasted William Jewell 87-84 in triple overtime this past Thursday, marking the first time two conference teams battled in three extra sessions since Saint Joseph's topped Quincy 104-103 in the NCAA Midwest Regional Championship on March 16, 2010 -- a win that vaulted the Pumas to the Elite Eight. It was also the first 3OT thriller during the regular season since Indianapolis defeated Lewis 113-109 on Feb. 21, 2008.

Conference Century Club

This past Thursday, Indianapolis became the first GLVC squad to reach the 100-point mark in conference play this season, with a 100-66 victory over McKendree. Prior to that contest, the Greyhounds had previously held the season-high for points scored in a conference game with 93 against Missouri S&T on Jan. 12. Last Sunday, Saint Joseph's nearly eclipsed the century mark with 99 points in a win over McKendree.

Dowe Did It

Chris Dowe led Bellarmine to three important road wins this past week, helping the Knights climb back to the top of the GLVC East standings. The 6-3 senior showed his leadership by contributing in all phases of the game. Over the course of the first two games of the week, Dowe turned in double-doubles in consecutive games, doing it with points, rebounds and assists. Against McKendree, he put up 10 points and 10 assists, only to follow it with 22 points and 10 rebounds against Saint Joseph's. He culminated his week with a 17-point, five-assist night against Indianapolis to conclude the week with 16.3 points, 5.7 rebounds and 5.7 assists. To top it off, Dowe reached a personal milestone during the week, becoming just the 13th player in Bellarmine history to surpass 1,500 points. Dowe currently stands at 1,508 points for his career.

GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

University of Wisconsin-Parkside senior forward Jeremy Saffold has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, after helping the Rangers to a 2-1 record last week, including a pair of upset wins over No. 3 Kentucky Wesleyan and No. 10 Southern Indiana.

In the week's opener against Lewis on Monday, Saffold recorded 22 points and five rebounds in the 77-74 loss. Facing two top-10 teams, Saffold then rallied the Rangers to two wins that placed UWP in a tie for first in the GLVC East with Bellarmine and Southern Indiana at 7-2.

On Thursday, UW-Parkside defeated 10th-ranked Southern Indiana 77-68 on the heels of 25 points on 8-of-14 (.571) shooting to go along with six boards. Saffold then responded Saturday with 11 points, six rebounds, two steals and a block in a close 60-59 victory over No. 3 Kentucky Wesleyan.

Saffold averaged 19.3 points and 6.0 rebounds per game last week, and continues to pace the conference with 19.8 points per outing, including a league-best 19.0 points each time out in GLVC play.

This is the second weekly honor of Saffold's career as he was also honored three weeks ago on Jan. 7.

UW-Parkside (12-5, 7-2 GLVC) hits the road to Saint Joseph's on Thursday before returning home to host ranked GLVC opponent in Indianapolis on Saturday.
