**Uniform Assignments:** Highest seed is the HOME team throughout the tournament, wears light uniforms, and will be assigned to the south bench.

Tournament Reception: There will be an awards reception on Thursday evening at 8:00 PM in the Quincy University Main Dining Room. There is no cost for participating institutions. Dress is casual and comfortable. The reception will offer an assortment of dessert and snack items including cookies, fruit, yogurt, granola, and ice cream; along with iced tea, lemonade, and iced water. The Main Dining Room is located at the corner of 18<sup>th</sup> St and Lind St. Buses can drop coaches and players off in front of the building. Buses should then park in Lot C, located along 18<sup>th</sup> St between Elm St & Lind St. Please make arrangements for your bus driver to pick your team up at the conclusion of the banquet. Bus drivers are invited to attend the banquet. It is mandatory that teams attend, pursuant to Section 1.A.8 in the GLVC handbook.

**Officials:** Officials will be assigned through Conference policies. All officials shall be NISOA rated. They will be on the field no later than 30 minutes before each scheduled game.

**Pre-Game Protocol:** The NCAA recommended pregame protocol will be used for all games.

**NOTE:** Teams playing in the second, third, and fourth games on Friday will be guaranteed at least 30 minutes of warm-up time on the playing field, regardless of whether the previous game goes into overtime or not. Weather permitting, and at the discretion of QU athletics administration, teams may access the practice fields just west of the facility to warm up prior to accessing the playing field.

**Overtime**: The current NCAA tie breaker will be used in all tournaments games. Please check the 2013 NCAA Soccer Rule Book for any clarification.

**Programs:** The GLVC will provide game programs for sale for \$1.00.

**T-Shirts:** A limited number of GLVC Tournament t-shirts will be available for sale which includes long sleeve dri-fit (\$30), short sleeve dri-fit (\$27), and the 2013 championship neon- short sleeve t-shirt (\$22). Cash and check are the only acceptable payments. Apparel will be available for sale at the banquet Thursday night.

**Bus Parking:** Buses should pull into the drive in front of the Connie Nieman Center for Music (1<sup>st</sup> paved drive on Seminary Road). Pull forward as far to the west as possible, but not into Lot L, and drop team off there. If parking is not available in that drive, additional parking is available on Seminary Road and in Lot K located on the north side of the North Campus Building, off 18<sup>th</sup> Street. A staff member will be there to greet you and show you to your locker room

**Fan Parking:** Parking is free and will be available in Lot L of North Campus and the grass/gravel lot just south of Legends Stadium. Additional parking is also available along Seminary Rd, and in Lot K located on the north side of the North Campus Building, off 18<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Locker Rooms:** Two visiting team locker rooms will be available on a rotating basis. Teams should bring their bags to the field with them for their scheduled games. Teams playing the second game on Friday will not have access to their locker rooms until after halftime of the first game.

**Towels:** Each team must provide their own shower and bench towels.



**Tournament Committee:** The tournament committee will consist of members form the GLVC, the tournament director, the host institution athletic director, and the AD liaison.

**Training Room Facilities:** Training room facilities on site will be available 1 ½ hours prior to the scheduled match. A certified trainer will be available during the entire championship. **Videotaping:** An area conducive to each team's videotaping need will be available. Each team is responsible to bring its own equipment and extension cord.

**Alcohol and Tobacco Policy:** Absolutely no alcohol or tobacco products are permitted inside the facility at any time. Security will be stationed at the entrance to Legends Stadium to ensure compliance with this policy.



## **Legends Stadium Evacuation Plan**





In the event of a mass evacuation for Legends Stadium fans would be directed to the south gate. Security personnel will open the wide portion of the south gate prior to evacuation to allow for safer egress. Players and referees would be directed to the east gate behind the player benches.

If area evacuation is the best course, (i.e., fire, disturbance, etc.) patrons will be directed to the parking areas and/or Seminary Road for pedestrian or vehicle traffic.

If it is best to secure in place (i.e., dangerous weather, etc.) attendees will be directed to the lower levels of the Gymnasium building.
