2013-14 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Limited Action This Week Due to Finals

With several GLVC schools in finals, just 11 men's basketball games are on the docket this week, including three by No. 2 Bellarmine. The Knights opened up the week with an 85-51 home win against West Virginia Tech on Monday. McKendree was the lone team in action on Tuesday, earning a 94-66 victory over Robert Morris-Springfield. Bellarmine returns to the court along with Southern Indiana for a doubleheader in the Fern Valley Hotel Classic at Knights Hall on Friday. The week closes out on Saturday with seven teams competing, five of which will be in action for the first time this week, including Illinois Springfield, Missouri S&T, Saint Joseph's, Truman State and William Jewell.

GLVC League Play Opens in the West

With the GLVC making the Jan. 20 travel-partner conference game available to move prior to the New Year, the entire West Division took advantage by moving up its league opener to last week. Among the conference headlines, Drury extended its school-record winning streak to 30 games with a 96-86 victory over Missouri S&T, Truman State remained unbeaten on the season with its first-ever GLVC win after a 79-68 decision at Quincy, and Missouri-St. Louis gave first-year head coach Bob Sundvold his first GLVC victory with a 74-69 result over Maryville. At William Jewell, the Cardinals recorded a win in their GLVC opener in dramatic fashion as Dwight Sistrunk, Jr. sank a 70-foot buzzer beater to give Jewell a 97-94 victory over Rockhurst.

GLVC Tops Nation With Four Ranked Teams in NABC Poll

The GLVC leads all NCAA Division II conferences with four teams ranked in the latest NABC/Division II poll, which was released Tuesday afternoon. Bellarmine and defending NCAA Champion Drury held steady for the second-straight week at second and third, respectively, while Southern Indiana moved up two spots to ninth, and Indianapolis jumped into the national rankings in 23rd. Additionally, Lewis is receiving votes outside the top 25. The conference quartet gave the GLVC the advantage nationally as the Great Northwest Athletic Conference and Peach Belt Conference follow with three representatives each. This is the first time the GLVC has had four teams ranked in the top 25 as well as three top-10 teams since former member Kentucky Wesleyan was third, Bellarmine was eighth, Southern Indiana was 10th and Indianapolis was 11th on Jan. 22, 2013. The rankings also continue to showcase two league squads in the top five for the third consecutive week, which has not occurred since the conference had a seven-week stretch from Dec. 6 to Jan. 17 during the 2011-12 season, including three straight polls featuring a trio of league programs in the top five.

Six Remain Unbeaten

Last week six GLVC teams were among 42 NCAA Division II teams that had yet to lose a game this year and this week that number has decreased to 28. However, all six GLVC squads remain undefeated as No. 2 Bellarmine (5-0), No. 3 Drury (7-0), No. 11 Southern Indiana (5-0), Indianapolis (6-0), Lewis (6-0) and Truman State (5-0) lead the conference contingent. As a league, the GLVC currently boasts a combined 68-28 (.708) non-conference record on the season.

USI's Nelson Gives Watson Memorable 100th Win

Rodney Watson picked up win No. 100 at Southern Indiana this past Saturday in a 92-69 victory over Kentucky State. Watson's milestone, however, was overshadowed by the impressive outing of GLVC Player of the Week Aaron Nelson. The senior forward scored a game-high 31 points and grabbed a single-game school record 27 rebounds in the win, which also bested the previous GLVC mark of 25, set by Kentucky Wesleyan's Antonio Garcia against Indianapolis on Feb. 21, 1998.

Three Over Thirty

While the talk prior to last week centered on Saint Joseph's Cameron Vines' two outings of 40 points or more this season, three GLVC standouts turned in the league's third-, fourth-, and fifth-highest scoring totals of the year last week. In Truman's 79-68 victory at Quincy on Saturday, Mike Carlson netted a career-high 37 points -- the most for a Bulldog since 1994. His performance was just one point more than the 36-point effort Rockhurst's Brandon McCann put up in the Hawks' 97-94 loss at William Jewell. In non-conference action, Indianapolis' Reece Cheatham scored 33 points in the Greyhounds' 86-72 victory over Oakland City last Wednesday.

When Wins Hit Seventy

This past Saturday Indianapolis defeated IU Northwest 109-39, marking the first 70-point margin of victory for a GLVC team since William Jewell defeated Baptist Bible College by 75 points, 118-43, on Nov. 22, 2011. Coincidentally, the largest margin of victory in recent years also came against IU Northwest as Saint Joseph's earned a 77-point win, 124-47, on Dec. 17, 2009.

Foster Posts First Triple-Double in S&T History

Bryce Foster recorded the first triple-double in school history this past Sunday with 22 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists to help lead Missouri S&T past Webster University, 95-79. The impressive outing was the first triple-double by a GLVC standout since Undy's Adrian Moss tallied 18 points, 10 rebounds, and 10 assists against UW-Parkside on Feb. 18, 2012. It is also one of five triple-doubles recorded in NCAA Division II play this year.

Century Club

The 2013-14 season is just a month old and already GLVC teams have netted 100 points or more in 14 contests. That figure exceeds the season totals for each of the previous three years. Last year eight teams managed to eclipse the 100-point mark, while 10 squads did so in 2011-12, and 11 accomplished the feat in 2010-11. In recent history, the GLVC saw 16 100-point contests during the 2009-10 and 2006-07 seasons, while 12 were recorded in 2007-08 and 14 were seen in 2008-09. Missouri S&T leads this year's pack with four 100-point games, while Indianapolis has three, and McKendree and Saint Joseph's have two each. Undy (97.2) and S&T (96.6) currently rank fifth and sixth nationally in scoring offense, respectively, while Saint Joseph's (95.3) is eighth and McKendree (91.0) is 18th.

The Best of the Best

Four GLVC squads and three league standouts currently rank first nationally in select statistical categories. Bellarmine (57.9) and Knights' guard Keisten Jones (83.3) are tops in field-goal percentage, Southern Indiana (17.6) and senior Aaron Nelson (15.2) lead the country in rebounding margin and rebounds per game, respectively, Undy (2.05) sits atop the nation in assist-turnover ratio, Truman State (8.4) is first in turnovers per game while Bulldog sophomore Cory Meyers is first in free-throw percentage (100.0). GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

University of Southern Indiana senior forward Aaron Nelson has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, it was announced by the league office Monday.

Despite playing in just one game last week, Nelson turned in arguably one of the most impressive single-game performances in conference history. In the Screaming Eagles' 92-69 win over Kentucky State, Nelson tied his career best with 31 points and recorded both a school and conference record with 27 rebounds. The 27 caroms bested the 39-year USI single-game record set in 1974, as well the GLVC record of 25, which was set by Kentucky Wesleyan's Antonio Garcia against Indianapolis on Feb. 21, 1998.

Nelson also shot 61.9 percent (13-21) from the field and 71.4 percent (5-7) from the free-throw line, while tallying two steals, one assist, and one blocked shot as well.

The Chicago Heights, Ill., native earns his third career Player of the Week award as he was also honored a few weeks back on Nov. 25, as well as Jan. 21, 2013.
