**2012-13 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES**

**Round Two of Divisional Play Begins Thursday**

While we turned the corner last week and began the second half of the conference slate, GLVC men's basketball tips Thursday to signify the start of the final half of divisional play. GLVC squads are seven divisional games in, with seven to go, and so far, Drury is the only team unscathed in divisional action. The Panthers completed a perfect 7-0 sweep of the West Division and currently sit atop the West with a 9-2 record, which includes a 2-2 mark against members of the East. Maryville posted a 6-1 record in the West, while Bellarmine and Southern Indiana were each 6-1 in the East. Looking ahead to this week, first-place divisional battles are on tap Saturday, as Southern Indiana (9-2 GLVC East) will host co-division leader UW-Parkside (9-2), while Drury (9-2 GLVC West) welcomes second-place Maryville (8-3). On Thursday, UW-Parkside travels to Owensboro to face Kentucky Wesleyan, USI hosts Lewis, Maryville heads to Missouri S&T, and Missouri-St. Louis plays at Drury.

**Taking a Look Back**

GLVC men's hoops concluded the first of two nine-game conference stretches last week, with UW-Parkside continuing to impress. The Rangers, who were picked by the league coaches to finish tied for sixth in the East Division, are currently tied for first with Southern Indiana at 9-2. UW-Parkside stopped Saint Joseph's last Thursday and then upset No. 15 Indianapolis 77-71 on Saturday. Thursday's competition was highlighted by No. 13 Southern Indiana defending its home court with a 62-49 victory over sixth-ranked Bellarmine.

**GLVC Boasts Four Teams in Nation's Top 25**

The GLVC leads the nation once again with four men's basketball teams ranked in the latest National Association of Basketball Coaches Division II Top 25 Poll, which was announced on Tuesday. No. 10 Southern Indiana paces the conference contingent that includes No. 11 Bellarmine, No. 21 Indianapolis, and No. 23 Kentucky Wesleyan. At No. 10, USI keeps the GLVC's top-10 streak intact as the conference has not gone without a top-10 squad since March 3, 2009.

**The Nation's Best**

In the latest NCAA statistical report, which was released Feb. 4, several teams and individuals rank among the nation's best in select stat categories. Six teams -- No. 2 Drury (20.3), No. 8 Bellarmine (14.1), No. 11 Indianapolis (13.8), No. 14 Kentucky Wesleyan (12.7), No. 17 Southern Indiana (12.5), and No. 24 UW-Parkside (11.2) -- rank among the nation's top 25 in scoring margin. Missouri-St. Louis (80.6) tops the country in free-throw percentage as does UMSL's Michael Weber (95.7), while KWC's Dazmond Starke (68.9) ranks second in field-goal percentage and UW-Parkside's Andy Mazurczak (3.39) is second in assist-turnover ratio. A complete breakdown of where the GLVC ranks among the NCAA's top 25 stat leaders can be found on page two of the weekly release.

**New Meaning to Tournament Title**

The GLVC announced this past Thursday that Deaconess Health System, a tri-state community health care provider, has been named the title sponsor of the 2013 Deaconess GLVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championship Tournaments. The announcement was made Thursday in Evansville, Ind., at the Ford Center -- site of the 2013 tournaments, March 7-10. In addition, the Evansville Sports Corporation will serve as the event's local organizing committee, ensuring the community is prepared for some of the nation's finest NCAA Division II basketball come March.

**Time to Talk Tickets**

Tickets for the 2013 Deaconess GLVC Basketball Championship Tournament will go on sale Friday, Feb. 8, through ticketmaster.com or by phone at (800) 745-3000, or through the Ford Center box office at (812) 422-1515. All-Tournament passes are \$35, while Session Flex Passes are \$25, allowing you access to any two of the first six sessions, excluding Sunday's finals. Single-session tickets are \$15 for adults and \$8 for students with a valid ID, while children aged six and under are admitted free of charge.

**UWP = U Will Protect?**

When breaking down the success of UW-Parkside this season, one could certainly point to a pair of Rangers who have dishd the ball with consistency and carefulness. Freshman Andy Mazurczak leads the conference with an assist/turnover ratio of 3.39, while teammate and junior Bryant Smith ranks second in the league at 2.59. UWP has also served up another layer of protection of the defensive side of the ball as sophomore Zygimantas Riauka is fourth in the GLVC with 1.32 blocks per game.

**A True "Triple" Double**

In what records indicate as the first time in conference history, the GLVC has experienced two triple-overtime contests in the same season, and this year's occurrences happened in consecutive weeks. This past Thursday, UW-Parkside defeated Saint Joseph's 109-99 in three extra sessions, exactly one week after Illinois Springfield outlasted William Jewell 87-84 in triple overtime.

**Block Party**

This past week, Southern Indiana standouts Keith DeWitt and Taylor Wischmeier hosted a block party in a pair of wins to help move the Screaming Eagles to the top of the GLVC East Division. DeWitt, the current GLVC Player of the Week, swatted a conference season-high six shots against Bellarmine, while Wischmeier answered Saturday with five blocks versus McKendree, which is tied for the second-highest total in the league this year.

**Quincy's Thompson Honored for Academic Success**

Quincy fifth-year senior forward Tyler Thompson was named last Friday to the Capital One Academic All-District IV team. Thompson is the only GLVC player to earn the honor. The 6-foot-5 forward is averaging 13.3 points and 4.7 rebounds this year and recently had a stretch of three consecutive games of at least 20 points.

**GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

University of Southern Indiana senior center Keith DeWitt has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, it was announced by the league office Monday. DeWitt helped USI to a sweep of GLVC games this week, including a win over No. 6 Bellarmine, which marked the Screaming Eagles' third victory over a top-10 team in the last six games.

DeWitt was dominating in the 62-49 win over the sixth-ranked Knights on Thursday, adding six blocked shots to his 18 points and 12 rebounds. He also dished out four assists while shooting 75 percent from the field (6-of-8) and a perfect 6-of-6 from the line.

The High Point, N.C., native finished the week with another impressive performance, this time on the road at McKendree. DeWitt dropped in a team-high 20 points while grabbing 11 rebounds and dishing three assists. He shot 69.2 percent (9-of-13) from the field to lead USI to a 78-68 decision over the Bearcats.

For the week, DeWitt averaged 19.0 points, 11.5 rebounds, 3.0 blocks, and 3.5 assists. He shot 71.4 percent (15-of-21) from the field and 66.6 percent from the line (8-of-12).

The back-to-back double-doubles were the third and fourth of the season for DeWitt, who garners his first-ever weekly award from the conference. His distinction this week also marks the first for a center this season and is the first time a USI player has been recognized by the league since teammate Aaron Nelson was honored on Jan. 21, 2013.
