Katie Martin, whose bat helped lead Grand Valley State to its first NCAA Division II quarterfinal appearance in 11 years and Kayla Cox, a senior at the University of Tampa who is the Division II leader in earned run average and one of the top strikeout pitchers in the nation, head the 2013 Daktronics, Inc., All-America softball team.

Martin – named for the second time in three years as the “Ron Lenz Player of the Year” and first to earn that honor for a second time, posted a .974 slugging percentage and a .461 batting average for the Lakers during the season. She also posted 19 home runs and is second in the nation with 80 runs batted in.

Meanwhile, Cox posted a 25-6 record for the Spartans with a 0.74 ERA, holding opponents to just a .115 batting average on the year as she threw seven no-hitters during the year. Cox is third in the nation in strikeouts as well, recording a school record 332 in 208 1/3 innings and gave up only 79 hits in that span.

The University of Indianapolis, which spent most of the second half of the 2013 season as Division II’s top-ranked team, had three selections to the first team in senior utility pitcher Jennifer DeMotte – her third citation on the first team – sophomore outfielder Casey Williamson and freshman pitcher Morgan Foley. DeMotte went 26-3 in the circle and batted .327, while Williamson hit .447 with 13 homers and 56 RBI and Foley posted a 28-5 mark with a 1.25 ERA and 319 strikeouts.

Defending NCAA Division II champion Valdosta State and Midwestern State, one of the top offensive teams in the nation with a .359 team batting average and .578 slugging mark, each had two first team picks as well. Shortstop Courtney Albritton, a repeat pick to the first team, made the squad after hitting .429 with 15 homers and 58 runs batted in from her position as did outfielder Morgan Johnson. Johnson batted .378 and ranked among the Gulf South Conference leaders in 10 offensive categories.

The Midwestern State first team selections were catcher Kim Jerrick, a .417 hitter with 19 home runs and 54 runs batted in and third baseman Kelley Schaefer, who hit .420 and drove in 69 runs on the strength of 13 homers.

This year’s national home run leader, Chrissy Stalf of Humboldt State, was named as the first team pick at first base; Stalf has belted 27 home runs to go along with a .400 batting average for the West Regional champions. The fourth infielder on the first team is Anderson University’s Jessica Neidigh, who posted the nation’s 15<sup>th</sup>-best batting average of .457.

The other position players named to the first team were Minot State outfielder Jen Dixon, who hit .447 with 50 runs batted in and North Carolina Pembroke utility player Brea Hartley, who batted .407 while splitting time behind the plate and in the outfield.

The final pitcher named to the 2013 squad was Fort Hays State’s Maddie Holub, who ranks second in the country in strikeouts with 345 as she went 29-4 with a 1.03 ERA – and also recorded a .426 average at the plate with 19 home runs for the Tigers.

The team is sponsored by Daktronics, Inc., an acknowledged world leader in scoring, timing and programmable display systems for virtually every sport at every level of competition. The team is voted on by the members of the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA).
