### 2013-14 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

**Divisional Play on the Docket for GLVC Teams This Week**  
This week's GLVC men's basketball action tips on Thursday with eight divisional games set to be contested. Among the headlines for Thursday, No. 14 Indianapolis heads to No. 2 Bellarmine, while Truman State hosts Missouri-St. Louis in a matchup of two teams currently tied for second in the West Division. Elsewhere, the GLVC's top scorer, Cameron Vines (25.0 ppg), leads Saint Joseph's down to Evansville to square off against No. 10 Southern Indiana and the league's top rebounder, Aaron Nelson (14.3 rpg). Nelson and the Eagles headline Saturday's slate as they welcome the 14th-ranked Greyhounds.

**GLVC Tops Nation with Five Ranked Teams in NABC Poll**  
For the third consecutive week, the GLVC leads all NCAA Division II conferences with five teams ranked in the latest NABC/Division II poll, which was released Tuesday afternoon. No. 2 Bellarmine, which also received two first-place votes, leads the conference contingent. Drury had its nation's longest winning streak end at 34 games last week by Bellarmine and slipped four spots to No. 7 in this week's poll. Southern Indiana, which suffered its first loss of the season last week to Drury, dropped two spots to No. 10, followed by No. 14 Indianapolis and No. 23 Lewis. This is the first time the GLVC has had five ranked teams over a course of three weeks since the league went on a four-week stretch of five squads in the top 25 from Feb. 7-28, 2012. With four women's teams ranked in the USA Today Sports Top 25 Coaches Poll, the GLVC leads the nation with a combined nine ranked basketball teams. Three of the six Division II institutions that are represented in both the men's and women's top 25 polls belong to the GLVC, including Drury (No. 7 men's/No. 10 women's), Indianapolis (No. 14/T-14), and Lewis (No. 23/25).

**The Week That Was**  
Four GLVC teams entered last week's conference action undefeated on the season. This week just one team, Bellarmine (12-0, 4-0 GLVC), remains unbeaten and joins six other teams in the country to have yet to suffer a blemish. In last week's marquee matchup, the second-ranked Knights held off the No. 3 and defending national champion Drury Panthers by a score of 85-77 on Thursday. The result ended Drury's 34-game winning streak, which was the longest in any NCAA division entering at that time. The contest also marked the first time in 13 years a GLVC game was contested between two conference opponents that were ranked among the nation's top-three teams. That same night, No. 17 Lewis was knocked from the unbeaten ranks after falling 83-79 in double-overtime at Maryville. Drury would then get back to its winning ways by stopping eighth-ranked Southern Indiana 64-56 in Evansville on Saturday, which marked the Screaming Eagles' first defeat of the season.

**Thirty (is) Something**  
So far this season 10 GLVC standouts have scored 30 points or more on 16 occasions, including the 33-point effort put up last Thursday (Jan. 9) by Truman State's Mike Carlson in the Bulldogs' 76-70 victory over Illinois Springfield. While Saint Joseph's Cameron Vines also netted 33 points in a win at Missouri S&T on Jan. 5, the New Year has seemed to scare some away from the 30-point mark. GLVC players have scored 29 points five times this season, all of which have occurred between Dec. 31 and Jan. 11. Vines tallied 29 points at Drury on Jan. 3 and against Rockhurst on Jan. 11, Lewis' Ryan Jackson reached 29 points in a non-conference New Year's Eve win over Trinity Christian, William Jewell's Clint McCullough turned in 29 at Saint Joseph's on Jan. 9, while Southern Indiana's Aaron Nelson posted 29 in the loss against Drury on Jan. 11. On the year, Vines (43-40-33) and Carlson (37-33-32) lead the league with three games each of 30 points or more.

**Double-Double the Fun**  
Thirty-one GLVC standouts have accumulated a total of 81 double-double outings this season, including 12 by Southern Indiana's Aaron Nelson. The USI senior forward was one of three players (Lewis' Julian Lewis & UW-Parkside's Zygimantas Riauka) to post a double-double in both conference games last week, while Nelson has now recorded one in each of his 12 games played this year. Additionally, three teams had multiple players contribute to the 16 total double-doubles recorded in the league last week, including Saint Joseph's Cameron Vines and Jon Smith, Truman's Mike Carlson and Seth Jackson, and William Jewell's Clint McCullough, D'Vante Mosby and Dwight Sistrunk. Having already turned in an impressive 31-point, 27-rebound effort against Kentucky State on Dec. 7, Nelson responded yet again last Thursday with a 24-point, 23-rebound performance against Missouri S&T. Those two outings on the boards are the top-two efforts in the league this year. Nelson is currently first in the country in rebounding (14.3) and 21st in scoring (21.9).

**Century Club**  
This past week's conference action saw three GLVC teams (Quincy, William Jewell, Illinois Springfield) eclipse the 100-point barrier while another (Quincy) nearly accomplished the feat again with 99 points in a loss on Sunday. Entering the weekend, league squads have now netted 100 points or more in 24 contests. That figure exceeds the combined season totals for the past two years (8, 2012-13, 10, 2011-12). There were 13 occasions of 100 points or more during the 2010-11 campaign. In recent history, the GLVC's previous record was 16 100-point contests, which came in both the 2009-10 and 2006-07 seasons. Missouri S&T leads this year's pack with five 100-point games, followed by William Jewell with four and Indianapolis with three. McKendree, Quincy, and Saint Joseph's each have two, while Bellarmine, Illinois Springfield, Maryville, Missouri-St. Louis, Rockhurst, and Southern Indiana have also eclipsed the 100-point mark once this season.

**The Nation's Purest Shooters**  
In this week's NCAA Division II national statistics report, six GLVC teams are found among the nation's top 10 in field-goal percentage. Bellarmine (55.8) leads the country while Drury (53.4) and UW-Parkside (53.3) are third and fourth, respectively. Indianapolis (52.2) is sixth overall, and Southern Indiana (51.3) and Maryville (51.1) follow in eighth and ninth. Individually, five GLVC sharpshooters can be found among the nation's top 20, led by Bellarmine's Jake Thelen (79.6) and Keisten Jones (69.4) in first and fifth, Drury's Cameron Adams (69.1) in eighth, UW-Parkside's Ziggy Riauka (66.7) in 12th, and UIndy's Joe Lawson (63.2) in 19th.

**Tickets on Sale for 2014 Deaconess GLVC Basketball Tournament**  
This past Thursday, the GLVC along with the Evansville Sports Corporation announced a title sponsorship renewal with Deaconess for the 2014 Deaconess GLVC Basketball Championship Tournaments. All-session and general admission tickets are now on sale. For the second straight year, the Ford Center in Evansville, Ind., will serve as the tournament site from March 6-9, featuring 14 games over four days. Tickets are available at ticketmaster.com, charge-by-phone at (800) 745-3000, or through the Ford Center Ticket Office. For additional information, please call 812-422-1515. All-Tournament passes are \$35, while Session Flex Passes are \$25, allowing access to any two of the first six sessions, excluding Sunday's finals. Single-session tickets are \$15 for adults and \$8 for students with a valid college ID, while children ages six and under are admitted free of charge, but must be accompanied by an adult.

**GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

University of Wisconsin-Parkside junior forward Zygimantas Riauka has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, it was announced by the league office Monday.

Riauka finished the week averaging 25.5 points, 10.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game as the Rangers remained undefeated in GLVC action with road wins over Missouri-St. Louis and Maryville. He poured on a career-high 28 points on 10-of-13 (.769) shooting while grabbing 10 rebounds and dishing out five assists in an 89-76 victory at UMSL on Thursday. Two days later, he scored 23 points on 7-of-9 (.778) from the floor, snatched 11 rebounds and dished five dimes in an 84-63 win at Maryville. Riauka concluded the week shooting 77.3 percent (17-of-22) from the floor with 10 assists and three blocks.

The Downers Grove, Ill., native has notched six straight double-doubles and currently ranks second in conference play in scoring (20.5) and third in rebounding (11.0).

This is the first career weekly honor for Riauka and the first for a Ranger since Jordan Mach was recognized on Nov. 11, 2013.

The Rangers (11-2, 4-0 GLVC) return to action on Thursday when they travel to Illinois Springfield for a 7:30 p.m. CT tip.
