2013-14 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Uindy to Host Top-20 Matchups This Week

GLVC men's basketball is back on court Thursday with eight intradivision matchups, highlighted by No. 17 Lewis traveling to No. 10 Indianapolis. East Division pacer No. 18 UW-Parkside and West leader No. 5 Drury are both on the road this week, beginning at Saint Joseph's and Quincy, respectively, on Thursday. The East-leading Rangers will then travel to Uindy for a Saturday afternoon matchup against the 10th-ranked Greyhounds, which will mark UWP's fourth ranked opponent in the last five games.

As The East Division Turns

Heading into last week's action, GLVC men's basketball followers knew a special week of hoops action in the East Division was in store. Three of the four-ranked East squads battled one another and in the end, it was a team that was unrated that stole the spotlight. UW-Parkside, which received just one vote outside the national rankings last week, upended then-No. 23 Lewis on Monday, No. 7 Bellarmine on Thursday, and No. 9 Southern Indiana on Saturday. Following its loss to the rival Rangers on Jan. 20, Lewis responded with home wins over both USI and Bellarmine. Indianapolis did its part by securing intradivision wins over Saint Joseph's, Illinois Springfield, and McKendree to move into a second-place tie with Lewis at 7-2 -- two games back of UW-Parkside.

GLVC One Vote Shy of NABC/DII Coaches Poll History

The GLVC fell one vote shy of earning six ranked men's basketball teams for the first time in league history, but its five teams in the NABC/Division II Poll still place all other conferences in the country. In the latest Division II poll released Tuesday, the GLVC is led by No. 5 Drury and No. 10 Indianapolis, while Southern Indiana, Lewis and UW-Parkside rank 16th through 18th, respectively. Bellarmine fell one vote shy of the 25th position in the poll and currently sits as the first team out with 47 points. The Knights dropped out of the top 25 for the first time since March 2, 2010, which ends a streak of 54 consecutive weeks in the poll. While the GLVC fell just a single vote shy of six ranked teams, its five teams marked the first time in conference history the GLVC has had five ranked squads in five consecutive weeks. A combined nine ranked GLVC men's and women's basketball teams lead the country as a nation's-best four squads are ranked on the women's side, including No. 7 Drury, No. 15 Quincy, No. 16 Indianapolis and No. 20 Lewis. Truman State is receiving votes outside the top 25.

Halfway Home

Nine conference games are in the books and nine contests remain in the league's 18-game schedule. At intermission of the 2014 GLVC season, UW-Parkside is the lone conference team without a blemish on its GLVC record, touting a perfect 9-0 mark. Drury leads the West Division with an 8-1 record, the lone loss coming to then-No. 2 Bellarmine. Individually, Saint Joseph's Cameron Vines leads the conference through the first nine GLVC contests with 24.8 points and 2.11 steals per game. Southern Indiana big man Aaron Nelson paces the conference's rebounders with 13.6 caroms each time out, while William Jewell's Dwight Sistrunk owns a league-best average of 6.78 assists per game. UW-Parkside's Zygimantas Riauka leads all conference shot blockers with 2.33 swats through nine league games.

Hot Shooting, Top to Bottom

The GLVC currently leads all NCAA Division II conferences in field-goal percentage, having made 7,939-of-16,426 attempts this season for a clip of 48.33 percent. The MIAA (47.56), Great Northwest (46.39) and Mountain East (46.21) follow. In addition, the GLVC and the Mountain East currently lead all conferences in scoring as each league posts a combined 81.9 points per game. The GLVC is also into sharing as the league tops the nation in total assists (4,258), which are 200 more than the runner-up PSAC.

The Nation's Purest Shooters

In this week's NCAA Division II national statistics report, seven GLVC teams are found among the nation's top 25 in field-goal percentage, including five in the top 10. Drury (53.3) leads the country while UW-Parkside (53.1) and Bellarmine (52.9) are third and fourth, respectively. Indianapolis (51.8) sits sixth overall, followed by No. 10 Southern Indiana (50.9), No. 14 Maryville (50.2) and No. 20 Lewis (49.6). Individually, four GLVC sharpshooters can be found among the nation's top 25, led by Bellarmine's Jake Thelen (76.5) in first, Drury's Cameron Adams (67.9) in sixth, UW-Parkside's Zygimantas Riauka (64.7) in 10th and Southern Indiana's Aaron Nelson (61.0) in 24th.

What's in a Name?

When breaking down the stats at the halfway point of the season, one name has arguably stood out from the rest in nearly every single category: Cameron. However, Cameron is not just one person. In fact, three GLVC standouts don the first name, including Drury's Cameron Adams and Kameron Bundy, and Saint Joseph's Cameron Vines. In terms of overall stats, all three namesakes rank among the league's top 11 in scoring as Vines (24.2) is first, Bundy (17.8) is seventh, and Adams (16.8) is 11th. Adams is also third in field-goal percentage (.679), Bundy is fifth in steals (1.81) and eighth in assists (4.19), and Vines is eighth in rebounding (7.7). In addition, Vines (34.89) and Bundy (33.44) rank second and sixth, respectively, in minutes played. All three namesakes came to play last week too. In all three Saint Joseph's setbacks, Vines turned in point totals of 27, 27, and 14 against Uindy, McKendree and Illinois Springfield, respectively, while Bundy (25) and Adams (20) scored 45 of Drury's 61 points in the Panthers' 61-58 win over Maryville on Saturday before a nationally-televised audience on CBS Sports Network.

The GLVC along with the Evansville Sports Corporation announced Jan. 9 a title sponsorship renewal with Deaconess for the 2014 Deaconess GLVC Basketball Championship Tournaments. All-Tournament passes are \$35, while Session Flex Passes are \$25, allowing access to any two of the first six sessions, excluding Sunday's finals. Single-session tickets are \$15 for adults and \$8 for students with a valid college ID, while children ages six and under are admitted free of charge, but must be accompanied by an adult.

GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

University of Wisconsin-Parkside sophomore guard Jimmy Gavin has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, it was announced by the league office Monday.

The sophomore guard came off the bench to average 22.7 points, 3.7 assists, and 2.7 rebounds per game last week, helping the red-hot Rangers down a trio of nationally-ranked squads. Gavin was 6-of-7 from the floor with 16 points in Monday night's 94-88 victory over No. 23 Lewis before pouring on a season-high 30 points on Thursday, helping UW-Parkside stun No. 7 Bellarmine, 76-74.

He concluded the memorable week with 22 points in Saturday's 82-71 win over No. 9 USI, which extended the Rangers' win streak to nine games.

The Bradley University transfer shot 71 percent (22-of-31) from the floor during the week, canning 41.7 percent (5-of-12) of his shots from three-point range. Gavin dished out 11 assists while collecting one steal and sinking 19 of his 22 free throw attempts.

This is the first career weekly honor for the Arlington Heights, Ill., native and the first for a Ranger since Zygimantas Riauka was recognized two weeks ago on Jan. 13. This is also the third honor for Parkside this season as Jordan Mach was named Player of the Week on Nov. 11, 2013.
