2013-14 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

NCAA Champions Showdown Highlights GLVC Week Two

The second full week of conference play is on the docket with eight cross-division games scheduled for both Thursday and Saturday. Thursday's slate is highlighted by 2011 NCAA Champion and No. 2 Bellarmine hosting 2013 NCAA Champion and No. 3 Drury in Louisville. The Panthers will then travel to Evansville for their third-straight top-20, and second-straight top-10 matchup against No. 8 Southern Indiana on Saturday. Drury defeated No. 16 Indianapolis at home this past Sunday.

A Clash of the Titans

The national spotlight will shine on Louisville, Ky., Thursday as the No. 3 and defending NCAA Champion Drury will do battle with No. 2 Bellarmine, the 2011 NCAA Champion. Bellarmine and Drury have held their respective ranks for five straight weeks, which marks the highest two GLVC teams have been ranked since Bellarmine was No. 1 and Kentucky Wesleyan was No. 2 in the Jan. 17, 2012 poll. This will be the first time in 13 years a GLVC game will be contested between two conference opponents that were ranked among the nation's top-three teams. In the 2001 GLVC Championship Tournament final, No. 3 Kentucky Wesleyan defeated No. 2 Southern Indiana 91-74, just weeks after the No. 4 Panthers defeated the No. 2 Screaming Eagles 91-89 in a Feb. 22 regular season matchup. Thursday's game will be the highest-ranked game during the regular season since No. 1 USI fell at home to No. 2 Kentucky Wesleyan 64-54 on Jan. 4, 1999.

GLVC Tops Nation with Five Ranked Teams in NABC Poll

The GLVC leads all NCAA Division II conferences with five teams ranked in the latest NABC/Division II poll, which was released Tuesday afternoon. Bellarmine and defending NCAA Champion Drury held steady for the fifth-straight week at No. 2 and No. 3, respectively, while the Knights earned two first-place votes. Southern Indiana maintained its position at No. 8, while Lewis surged five positions to No. 17 and Indianapolis fell two spots to No. 19 following last weekend's loss to No. 3 Drury. This is the first instance the GLVC has had five teams ranked in the top 20 since Feb. 28, 2012 (No. 1 Bellarmine, No. 10 Northern Kentucky, No. 13 Southern Indiana, No. 14 Kentucky Wesleyan and No. 20 Indianapolis). The rankings also continue to showcase two league squads in the top five for the seventh consecutive week, which has not occurred since the conference had a seven-week stretch from Dec. 6 to Jan. 17 during the 2011-12 season, including three straight polls featuring a trio of league programs in the top five.

The Week That Was

After the first full week of conference action, six GLVC teams are without a blemish on their league records, including Drury (3-0) and Missouri-St. Louis (3-0) in the West Division, and Bellarmine (2-0), Lewis (2-0), Southern Indiana (2-0) and UW-Parkside (2-0) in the East. The week was highlighted by a top-20 matchup with No. 3 Drury scoring an 83-69 home victory over No. 16 Indianapolis. Remarkably, the severe winter weather forced the postponement of just one conference game, but now that same weather has affected that same matchup once again. Maryville was originally scheduled to play at McKendree on Sunday, but the wintry weather postponed the game to this past Monday. Conditions then prevented Monday's tip from occurring, so both schools have agreed to meet on Monday, Feb. 17 at McKendree. The men's game will begin at 7:30 p.m. CT.

Final Four Unbeatens

Four of the 12 NCAA Division II teams that have yet to lose during the 2013-14 men's basketball season belong to the GLVC. No. 2 Bellarmine (10-0), No. 3 Drury (11-0), No. 8 Southern Indiana (10-0), and No. 17 Lewis (8-0) lead the conference contingent. No. 19 Indianapolis dropped its first game of the season last Sunday in an 83-69 loss to No. 3 Drury. This Thursday, at least one more GLVC squad will fall from the unbeaten ranks as No. 2 Bellarmine hosts No. 3 Drury.

USI's Nelson Tabbed National Player of the Month

Southern Indiana senior forward Aaron Nelson has been named the Division II Bulletin National Player of the Month for December, it was announced on Tuesday. Nelson becomes the fifth Screaming Eagle in the history of the program to win the award and the first since Jamar Smith in 2009. In December, Nelson earned his second GLVC Player of the Week award and led the eighth-ranked Eagles to a perfect 4-0 mark in the month. He averaged 21.3 points, 14.5 rebounds, 2.0 blocks, and 1.0 steals per game, while shooting 62.7 percent from the field (32-51) and 75.0 percent from the stripe (21-28). Overall, Nelson has posted a double-double in each of his 10 outings this year, a mark that ranks third nationally. Nelson paces the country with 13.5 rebounds per game, while USI leads the nation with a rebounding margin of 18.7.

The Nation's Purest Shooters

In this week's NCAA Division II national statistics report, seven GLVC teams are found among the nation's top 18 in field-goal percentage, while league squads also command five of the top-six positions. Bellarmine (55.8) and Drury (54.6) are first and second in the country, while Southern Indiana (53.6), UW-Parkside (52.8) and Indianapolis (52.5) are ranked 4-5-6, respectively. Maryville (51.9) sits ninth, while Lewis (50.7) is 18th. Individually, six GLVC sharpshooters can be found among the nation's 25, led by Bellarmine's Jake Thelen (78.2) in first, Drury's Cameron Adams (71.0) in fourth, Bellarmine's Keisten Jones (70.6) in fifth, UW-Parkside's Ziggy Riauka (64.5) in 18th, Ulndy's Joe Lawson (64.1) in 19th, and USI's Aaron Nelson (62.3) in 24th.

Sharing The Scoring Success

The GLVC has put forth quite the offensive effort so far this season. Four teams rank in the nation's top 25 in scoring offense, six are found in the scoring margin category, while seven are rated for best field-goal percentage. However, given the depth of the league, there is no one school that reigns supreme in these categories. Missouri S&T leads the conference core in scoring offense at No. 2 with 96.0 points per game, while Bellarmine paces the league in scoring margin (7th, 18.6) and field-goal percentage (1st, 55.8). Drury (8th, 43.3) has been the most successful league squad from beyond the arc, while Rockhurst (78.4) also ranks eighth nationally and leads the GLVC in free-throw percentage. The current GLVC scoring leader? It's Saint Joseph's Cameron Vines, who ranks sixth nationally with 24.8 points per game.

2014 GLVC Basketball Tournament Tickets Now on Sale

All-Tournament passes are \$35, while Session Flex Passes are \$25, allowing access to any two of the first six sessions, excluding Sunday's finals. Single-session tickets are \$15 for adults and \$8 for students with a valid college ID, while children ages six and under are admitted free of charge, but must be accompanied by an adult.

GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Saint Joseph's College junior guard Cameron Vines has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, it was announced by the league office Monday.

Vines turned in the conference's top-two scoring outputs last week to average 31.0 points per game while helping the Pumas to a 1-1 record on the road to open league play.

In Friday's conference opening 80-66 loss at No. 3 Drury, the defending NCAA Champion, Vines netted a game-high 29 points on 8-of-16 (.500) shooting, which included 3-of-4 (.750) from beyond the arc. He also made 10-of-13 (.769) attempts from the free-throw line and had the Pumas poised for an upset with the team down just five points with three minutes to play.

The Columbus Ohio, native, who transferred in from Florida Southern, then put up a 33-point effort along with seven rebounds and three assists in the Pumas' 94-87 victory at Missouri S&T on Sunday. Vines was 9-of-14 (.643) shooting as well as 15-of-17 (.882) from the charity stripe.

Vines, who is sixth nationally and first in the league with 24.8 points per game on the season, earns his first career weekly honor from the conference and is the first Puma to be recognized by the league since Andrew Helmer on Feb. 1, 2010.

The Pumas will return home to the Richard F. Scharf Alumni Fieldhouse to play William Jewell College on Thursday evening at 7:30 p.m. CT.
