2014-15 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

GLVC Slate to Officially Begin Thursday in Kansas City
The 37th league season of Great Lakes Valley Conference men's basketball will officially get underway Thursday in Kansas City as William Jewell travels to Rockhurst for a 7:30 p.m. tip. Three other GLVC games will be contested on Saturday as Quincy travels to Truman State, Drury heads to Missouri S&T, and Saint Joseph's hosts Indianapolis. The conference season gets an abbreviated start prior to the New Year as league scheduling allows travel partners within the GLVC to mutually agree to move their Monday, Jan. 19 game to any day before Dec. 31, with exception of the Dec. 22-28 NCAA Division II dark period. A full slate of conference games will commence Thursday, Jan. 2. Outside of conference play, the GLVC has 18 other games scheduled this week with Bellarmine and Southern Indiana as the only two teams league teams not in action.

Perfect Start to the Week

The GLVC went a perfect 4-0 Monday night in dominating fashion as the league outscored its opponents by a margin of 376-215. Winners included Illinois Springfield (81-55 over Lincoln), Maryville (100-63 over William Woods), Missouri S&T (106-46 over Ozark Christian) and William Jewell (81-51 over Graceland).

Two on Tap Tuesday

Drury and Quincy will be in action Tuesday evening as the Panthers host Central Christian at 7 p.m., while Quincy welcomes Benedictine-Springfield at 7:30 p.m.

Strong Start to the Season

Heading into this week's conference slate, the GLVC has combined for a 57-22 (.722) record, including a 32-8 (.800) mark in the East Division and a 25-14 (.641) effort in the West.

Three Teams Ranked, Three Others Receiving Votes

Three GLVC teams are ranked in the latest NABC/Division II rankings, which were released Tuesday afternoon. Bellarmine sits third overall, while Drury and Indianapolis are 14th and 16th, respectively. Additionally, Lewis, Southern Indiana and UW-Parkside are receiving votes outside the top 25. For Bellarmine, the ranking is the Knights' highest since earning the No. 2 spot in the Jan. 14, 2014 poll. It is also the best ranking for a GLVC team since Drury was ranked second in the Feb. 18, 2014 poll.

Keep it Down

Four GLVC teams currently rank among the top 25 in the country in scoring defense, led by Missouri-St. Louis. The Tritons allow 61.0 points per game to rank 16th overall, just ahead of Indianapolis (61.8) in 20th. Lewis (62.0) and Maryville (62.0) sit tied for 23rd.

GLVC Among Nation's Top Shooters

Five GLVC teams and four individuals currently rank among the top 25 statistical leaders in field goal percentage across all of NCAA Division II. UW-Parkside (54.1) leads the way in sixth, followed by McKendree (53.2), Lewis (53.2), and Indianapolis (53.1) in 15th, 16th, and 17th, respectively, while Bellarmine (52.4) is 21st. Individually, Ulndy's Brennan McElroy (76.6) is fourth, McKendree's Matt Holmes (75.6) is seventh, Drury's Cameron Adams (66.7) is 22nd, and Bellarmine's Jake Thelen (66.1) is 23rd. Last season Thelen made 74 percent of his shots to lead all of Division II.

Dish the Dimes

Ulndy's Lucas Barker, who was named the 2013 GLVC Co-Freshman of the Year while competing at then-league member Kentucky Wesleyan, has shown his selfless acts this holiday season as he ranks second nationally with 8.7 assists per game. Barker's efforts have also helped the Greyhounds to a ranking of fifth with 21.3 helpers each time out. Despite his short tenure in Owensboro, Barker ranks fifth in the KWC annals in career assist average and seventh in career steal average.

Three For Thirty

Three GLVC standouts have already eclipsed the 30-point mark for the season, including Maryville's Armon Provo, who set the league's season high with 38 points in Monday's 100-63 win against William Woods. The 38 points are currently tied for the sixth-most scored in Division II this season, and are the most scored within the conference since former Truman State standout and 2013-14 co-GLVC Player of the Year Mike Carlson went for 40 against Quincy on Feb. 27, 2014. Elsewhere this season, Southern Indiana's Gavin Schumann netted 33 points in the victory over Kentucky State on Nov. 22, while Drury's Cameron Adams finished with 30 points against Cameron on Nov. 28.

GLVC Championship Tournament Moves to Missouri

The 2015 GLVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championship Tournament has relocated to Family Arena in St. Charles, Missouri, just minutes outside St. Louis. The league's premiere event had been held the past two years at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana, but a two-year schedule conflict with the venue required the GLVC to search for a new two-year agreement. Both the 2015 and 2016 tournaments will be held in St. Charles. The 2015 event will begin with first-round competition on campus sites on March 1, with eight quarterfinalists on both the men's and women's side advancing to Family Arena for tournament action, March 5-8. Tickets for the 2015 GLVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championship Tournament are expected to go on sale in mid December.
