### 2013-14 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

**Cross-Divisional Play Returns...and Winter Weather Too**  
 Cross-divisional play returns to GLVC men's basketball this week as members of the East Division will battle conference foes from the West. A winter storm that dropped anywhere from 4-10 inches of snow blanketed most of GLVC Country on Tuesday, but no game times are expected to be affected. Newcomer Truman State will welcome Southern Indiana on Thursday and Bellarmine on Saturday, while Indianapolis brings its five-game winning streak west to face Maryville and Missouri-St. Louis. Drury, a winner of seven straight, heads east to face McKendree and Illinois Springfield.

#### The Week That Was

For the first time in GLVC action this season, UW-Parkside suffered a loss as No. 10 Indianapolis defended its home court this past Saturday with an 82-60 victory over the then-No. 18 Rangers. Despite the loss, Parkside remains one game ahead of UIndy in the East Division standings. Lewis and Southern Indiana follow in third at 8-3 as the Flyers and Screaming Eagles earned wins over Saint Joseph's and McKendree, respectively. After a Thursday night overtime scare at Quincy, No. 5 Drury fended off a tough Truman squad in Kirksville, Mo., winning 88-78 to move to 10-1 in league play. The victory doubled Drury's West Division lead to two games over the Bulldogs, who fell to 8-3 in the GLVC. In addition to Drury's close contest with Quincy on Thursday, No. 10 Indianapolis defeated No. 17 Lewis in another East Division top-20 matchup, while all four West Division games were each decided by five points or less.

#### Truman State, S&T Stage Scoring Showdown

Truman State outlasted Missouri S&T in a 109-105 overtime thriller last Thursday that saw the Bulldogs' Mike Carlson net a school-record 48 points while S&T's Bryce Foster netted a career high of 36 points in the loss. Carlson's output is tied for the third-highest point total in Division I or II this season and is the most a GLVC player has scored since UW-Parkside's LaVontay Fenderson dropped 52 against Saint Joseph's on Feb. 12, 2009. Coupled with Foster's efforts, Thursday also marked the first time the GLVC had two players score more than 35 points in the same night since UIndy's Darius Adams scored 37 at Maryville and Rockhurst's Aaron Hill netted 41 against Bellarmine on Jan. 7, 2010. Furthermore, no two GLVC players have scored more than 35 points in the same game since Bellarmine's Matt Otte (43) and Lewis' Brandon Dagens (37) battled each other on Feb. 10, 2007.

#### GLVC One Vote Shy of NABC/DII Coaches Poll History

The GLVC remains the nation's top NCAA Division II basketball conference as five men's teams are ranked in the NABC/Division II Poll for a league-record sixth consecutive week. In the latest Division II poll released Tuesday, the GLVC is led by No. 4 Drury and No. 8 Indianapolis, while Southern Indiana is 15th, UW-Parkside is 20th and Lewis is 22nd. For the second straight week, Bellarmine is the first team outside the top 25, falling just three votes shy of the 25th position this week. A combined nine ranked GLVC men's and women's basketball teams lead the country as a nation's-best four squads are ranked on the women's side, including No. 9 Drury, No. 11 Quincy, No. 16 Lewis and No. 19 Indianapolis.

#### Hot Shooting, Top to Bottom

The GLVC currently leads all NCAA Division II conferences in field-goal percentage, having made 8,836-of-18,321 attempts this season for a clip of 48.23 percent. The MIAA (47.56), Mountain East (46.43), and Great Northwest (46.32) follow. In addition, the GLVC and the Mountain East currently lead all conferences in scoring as each league posts a combined 81 points per game. The GLVC is also into sharing as the league tops the nation in total assists (4,749), which are nearly 300 more than the runner-up PSAC.

#### Among The Nation's Best

In this week's NCAA Division II national statistics report, several GLVC teams and individuals rank among the top five nationally in select statistical categories. Bellarmine's Jake Thelen is tops in the country in field-goal percentage (74.8), Southern Indiana's Aaron Nelson leads the nation in rebounds per game (13.1) and double-doubles (17), and Truman's Reed Mells is first overall in assist-turnover ratio (3.74). On the team side, Drury (52.9), UW-Parkside (52.8) and Bellarmine (52.5) ranked second, third and fifth, respectively, in field-goal percentage, Southern Indiana is second in rebounding margin (16.0), Lewis is third in turnovers per game (9.1), Truman is fourth in assist-turnover ratio (1.75), Drury is fourth in three-point field-goal percentage (43.9), and Missouri S&T is fifth in scoring offense (90.9). #### GLVC Honored With NCAA Division II Award of Excellence

The GLVC was honored recently by the NCAA with the Division II Award of Excellence for its community engagement efforts at the 2013 Deaconess GLVC Basketball Championship Tournament in Evansville, Ind. "March on Main Street" and the GLVC Youth Clinic were joint efforts coordinated between the GLVC and the Evansville Sports Corporation to promote the tournament in the community and provide activities to attract fans to the event. One winner was announced from each of the 24 NCAA Division II conferences, but the GLVC was one of just two (Lone Star Conference) league offices to be recognized as the remaining 22 were member institutions.

#### Tickets on Sale for 2014 Deaconess GLVC Basketball Tournament

The GLVC along with the Evansville Sports Corporation announced Jan. 9 a title sponsorship renewal with Deaconess for the 2014 Deaconess GLVC Basketball Championship Tournaments. All-session and general admission tickets are now on sale. For the second straight year, the Ford Center in Evansville, Ind., will serve as the tournament site from March 6-9, featuring 14 games over four days. Tickets are available at ticketmaster.com, charge-by-phone at (800) 745-3000, or through the Ford Center Ticket Office. For additional information, please call 812-422-1515. All-Tournament passes are \$35, while Session Flex Passes are \$25, allowing access to any two of the first six sessions, excluding Sunday's finals. Single-session tickets are \$15 for adults and \$8 for students with a valid college ID, while children ages six and under are admitted free of charge, but must be accompanied by an adult.

**GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

University of Indianapolis junior forward Joe Lawson has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, it was announced by the league office Monday.

Lawson averaged 22.5 points on 51.6 (16-of-31) shooting and 7.5 rebounds per game last week as the No. 10 Greyhounds defended their home court against a pair of top-25 teams in No. 17 Lewis and No. 18 UW-Parkside. UIndy broke a second-place tie in the GLVC East standings with an 80-66 win versus the Flyers on Thursday, and two days later handed the division-leading Rangers a 82-60 defeat – their first loss in conference play this year.

On Thursday against Lewis, Lawson netted 13 points and tacked on three rebounds, while setting the tone early with a pair of 3-pointers in the opening three minutes of the contest. He had scored only one triple entering the game against the Flyers.

In Saturday's win over one of the nation's hottest teams, Lawson amassed a career-high 32 points, 12 rebounds and two steals to deny UW-Parkside its 11th-straight win and fourth consecutive victory over a ranked team. He scored 11 of the team's first 13 points, including two dunks, an offensive put-back and a 3-pointer. Lawson's performance was his second double-double of the season. It was also the first 30-point output by a Greyhound in a conference game since January 2012.

On the season, Lawson is averaging 15.8 points and 6.7 rebounds per game.

This is the first career weekly honor for the Indianapolis native and the first for a Greyhound since Adrian Moss was recognized by the league on Jan. 23, 2012.
