### 2014-15 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### Top Divisional Matchups Headline Thursday's Tip-Offs

Two divisional showdowns are on tap in GLVC men's basketball action Thursday as East Division leader and top-ranked Indianapolis travels to UW-Parkside, while West Division leader Drury welcomes Truman State. The Greyhounds are a perfect 9-0 in conference play, while the Rangers just lost to Bellarmine last Saturday to fall into a tie for second place with the Knights at 8-1. Drury owns a 7-2 GLVC mark at the halfway point of the season, and hosts a Bulldogs team tied with UMSL for second place in the West at 6-3.

#### Halfway Home

It's hard to believe for some, but last Saturday's GLVC games marked the ninth league contest for each team, which was the official halfway point of the 18-game conference season. Since 2008, four teams -- Bellarmine (2011), Drury (2013, 2008) and Northern Kentucky (2009) -- have led their respective division at the halfway point and gone on to claim the conference title. Defending GLVC Champion Southern Indiana was fourth in the East Division at last year's intermission, and was second in the East during its title run in 2012. Bellarmine was the third-best team in the East at the halfway point of the 2010 conference season, before winning the league title two months later.

#### Reviewing the Rankings

In taking a look back at the GLVC Preseason Poll, now that we are halfway through the conference season, the 16 league coaches had a pretty good pulse back in October on how the league was going to play out in the West. As published on the second page of the weekly release, GLVC coaches picked Drury as the unanimous selection to win the West, followed by Missouri-St. Louis, Quincy and Truman State. Currently, Drury holds a slim lead in the West at 7-2, followed by UMSL and Truman at 6-3. In the East, top-ranked Indianapolis was picked to finish third in the division behind Bellarmine and Lewis, although three coaches gave the Greyhounds first-place votes. UW-Parkside was picked fourth, but has responded with an 8-1 league mark that is tied with Bellarmine for second place.

#### No. 1 Ulndy Leads Three GLVC Teams Ranked in National Poll

Three GLVC teams are ranked in the latest NABC/Division II rankings, which were released Tuesday afternoon. For the second straight week, Indianapolis is ranked No. 1 and the 17-0 Greyhounds are now poised to match their best start in school history as the 1996-97 team opened with 18 straight wins. The GLVC has not had a No. 1 ranked team in consecutive weeks since a five-week span from Jan. 17-Feb. 14, 2012 when Kentucky Wesleyan was ranked first on Jan. 17, followed by No. 1 Bellarmine for four straight weeks. Elsewhere in the poll, Bellarmine is ranked sixth, one spot up from last week, while UW-Parkside dropped from 19th to 20th after a loss to the Knights in Louisville on Saturday.

#### GLVC Nation's Only Conference With Undefeated Teams

With Indianapolis at 17-0 and the Lewis women's basketball team off to an 19-0 start, the GLVC is the only Division II conference to have an undefeated men's and women's basketball team.

#### Undefeated Ulndy One of Two Unbeaten Teams

At 17-0, Indianapolis is one of just two undefeated DII teams in the country, joining Lincoln Memorial (18-0), which is ranked second nationally. This is the best start for a GLVC men's program since No. 2 Southern Indiana opened the season 23-0 overall and 14-0 in GLVC play during the 2009-10 campaign, before suffering its first loss to Kentucky Wesleyan on Feb. 15, 2010.

#### Top-Ranked Hounds Among Elite Conference Company

For the first time in the 36-year history of the GLVC, a conference team has been ranked No. 1 in both the men's and women's polls during the same week for consecutive weeks. The Lewis women's team enters its third week at No. 1, while the Indianapolis men's team is No. 1 for the second consecutive week. This marks just the third season in conference history that two GLVC programs have been ranked No. 1 at the same time. The Kentucky Wesleyan men and Northern Kentucky women were ranked first in the Dec. 19, 2001 poll, while both Southern Indiana men's and women's teams owned the top spot on Dec. 15, 1997.

#### Ulndy Giveth and Taketh Away

Over the course of the past three weeks, Ulndy's Lucas Barker and Brennan McElroy have set the conference's single-game highs for the season in both assists and steals. McElroy swiped a season-high eight steals against Illinois Springfield on Saturday, just a week after his teammate Barker set the league's season high with 13 assists at Rockhurst on Jan. 10 and then 15 dimes against Southern Indiana on Jan. 17. Barker's total was the most in the league since Bellarmine's Chartrael Hall dished 15 dimes against Northern Kentucky on Feb. 26, 2009. McElroy's eight steals are the most in the conference since Illinois Springfield's Brandon Snowden swiped 10 balls against Drury on Feb. 8, 2014.

#### Making a Career From the Floor

Ulndy's Brennan McElroy, Bellarmine's Jake Thelen and Drury's Cameron Adams rank in the top five among NCAA Division II active career leaders in field goal percentage. Currently McElroy leads all shooters in NCAA Division I, II and III with a .698 career clip, having made 291 of his 417 attempts in 90 games. Thelen (67.9) is third overall, while Adams (63.5) is fifth. Across all divisions, Thelen remains third and Adams is seventh, just behind the top DI player, Jordan Parks (64.6) from N.C. Central. Also of note, UW-Parkside's Andy Mazurczak (59.7) is 31st across all divisions. From a scoring perspective, Saint Joseph's Cameron Vines is Division II's active career leader with 22.4 points per game.

#### GLVC Championship Tournament Tickets on Sale

Tickets for the 2015 GLVC Basketball Championship Tournament went on sale Monday at MetroTix.com. This year's event will be held at Family Arena in St. Charles, Missouri, March 5-8. All-Tournament passes (\$38) along with general admission adult (\$18) and student (\$11) single-session passes are available.

**GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

Drury University junior guard Kameron Bundy has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Player of the Week for men's basketball, it was announced by the league office Monday.

In two conference road wins at Maryville and Missouri-St. Louis last week, Bundy averaged 25 points, 4.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.5 steals per game.

He scored 22 points on 6-of-13 shooting for in the Panthers' 71-54 victory at Maryville on Thursday. He was 4-for-9 from three-point range and 6-for-6 from the free-throw line, while also adding five assists and two rebounds in 35 minutes of action. ??

Two days later, the Nixa, Missouri, native led the Panthers with a career-high 28 points in an 80-76 overtime win at Missouri-St. Louis. He pulled down seven boards with and added three assists and two steals in the victory

This is the second weekly award of Bundy's career as he was honored back on Feb. 17, 2014 – the last time a Panther standout earned a weekly accolade from the league.
