2014-15 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Second Full Week of GLVC Play Tips Thursday

GLVC men's basketball is back in action this week with a full slate of eight league games on Thursday and Saturday. Indianapolis heads to William Jewell and Rockhurst this week as the lone team 3-0 in GLVC play, but six other teams are off to a 2-0 start. Bellarmine, Lewis, Southern Indiana and UW-Parkside are off to a perfect start in the East Division, while Maryville and Missouri-St. Louis swept the weekend in the West. Bellarmine and Southern Indiana take those unbeaten conference marks to Drury this week. The Panthers are 2-1 in league play and 8-3 overall.

Six GLVC Teams Receiving Recognition in National Poll

Three GLVC teams are ranked in the latest NABC/Division I rankings, which were released Tuesday afternoon. After jumping from ninth to seventh in the last poll, Indianapolis improved two more positions to fifth, jumping ahead one spot of Bellarmine, which stayed sixth overall. Lewis also moved ahead two positions from 23rd to 21st this week. Additionally, Drury, UW-Parkside and Southern Indiana are receiving votes outside the top 25.

Undefeated UIndy Among the Elite Eight

At 11-0, Indianapolis is one of just eight undefeated DI teams in the country. The Greyhounds were tested last week at home against then-No. 19 Drury, but managed to handle the Panthers by a 74-57 margin. UIndy went on to defeat Missouri S&T 98-74 on Sunday. The other undefeated teams in the country include UC Colo. Springs (13-0), Lander (12-0), Lincoln Memorial (12-0), St. Edward's (12-0), Tarleton State (12-0), Colorado Mines (11-0), and West Liberty (10-0).

GLVC, Peach Belt Only Leagues With Unbeatens

With Indianapolis at 11-0 and the Lewis women's basketball team off to a 13-0 start, the GLVC is one of just two Division II conferences to have an undefeated men's and women's basketball team. The Peach Belt Conference currently boasts a 13-0 Columbus State women's team and a 12-0 Lander men's squad.

Saint Joseph's Vines Soaring in Scoring

Saint Joseph's sharp shooter Cameron Vines netted 38 points in the Pumas' 111-99 shootout loss to Missouri S&T last Friday, which tied the conference's season high for points in a game. Maryville's Arnon Provo dropped 38 against William Woods on Dec. 1. Last year, GLVC players reached the 40-point mark four times, including two times by Vines (43, 40). Truman State graduate Mike Carlson went for 48 and 40 points. Vines currently ranks 23rd in the nation with 21.5 points per game and is first among Division II active career scorers with 23.2 points each time out.

Buckets & Boards

Four GLVC standouts currently rank among in the top 25 in Division II for double-doubles. Missouri-St. Louis' Aareon Smith ranks eighth overall with seven double-doubles on the season, followed by Bellarmine's Jake Thelen (6) in 13th and UIndy's Brennan McElroy (5) and UW-Parkside's Ziggy Riauka (5) tied for 24th.

Speaking of Smith

UMSL's Aareon Smith garnered two of those seven double-doubles this past weekend in wins over Illinois Springfield and McKendree, and has now reached double figures in both categories in five of the last six games. After posting 14 points and 11 boards against UIS, Smith filled the stat sheet with a career-high 24 points, while adding 12 rebound and seven assists against McKendree on Sunday.

Success in Shooting - Part I

When looking at the 24 NCAA Division II conferences nationwide, the GLVC ranks first in the country in field goal percentage. From top to bottom, GLVC teams have combined for a 47.35 field goal percentage, which ranks better than second-place Gulf South Conference at 47.28. Within the league, five GLVC teams rank among the nation's top 25 in field goal percentage. Indianapolis (52.5) is second overall, followed by No. 11 Bellarmine (52.2), No. 13 UW-Parkside (52.0), No. 20 Truman State (52.5) and No. 23 Maryville (51.9). Individually, UIndy's Brennan McElroy (73.4) ranks second overall, while Bellarmine's Jake Thelen (70.1) is fourth, Quincy's Scottie Bruxvoort (66.7) is 10th, and Drury's Mike Nuwelu (62.5) is 16th.

Success in Shooting - Part II

UIndy's Brennan McElroy, Bellarmine's Jake Thelen and Drury's Cameron Adams rank in the top five among active career leaders in field goal percentage, regardless of NCAA Division. Currently McElroy is the only college basketball player in the country to boast a shooting percentage over 70 percent as his 70.1 clip rates first across all divisions. Thelen (69.2) is third overall, while Adams (63.3) is fifth. DI Tarleton State's Davene Carter (69.5) ranks second and DIII Bowdoin's John Swords (67.0) is fourth. The highest-ranking DI player is Sim Bhullar (63.3) of New Mexico State in sixth. Also of note, UW-Parkside boasts two players on the nation's top 50 career list. Andy Mazurczak (60.5) is 24th and Ziggy Riauka (57.5) is 49th.

Likin' the Freebies

Keeping with NCAA active career leaders, three GLVC standouts have been quite successful at the free-throw line during their time on campus. Lewis' Ryan Jackson (438) is fourth in made free throws in a career, while Truman's Seth Jackson (400) and Drury's Cameron Adams (386) are seventh and eighth, respectively.

Parkside Perfection

In UW-Parkside's 71-70 victory over McKendree on Sunday, the Rangers set a conference season high with a 20-for-20 performance at the free-throw line. It is the most impressive GLVC team performance at the charity stripe since Southern Indiana went 19-for-19 against Missouri-St. Louis on Feb. 1, 2007.

Senior Leadership

Four seniors currently pace the GLVC in both scoring and rebounding. Saint Joseph's Cameron Vines (21.5), Truman's Seth Jackson (21.3), USI's Gavin Schumann (20.5) and UIndy's Joe Lawson rank in the top four in scoring, while Bellarmine's Jake Thelen (11.0), UW-Parkside's Ziggy Riauka (9.7), UIndy's Brennan McElroy (9.1) and UMSL's Aareon Smith (9.1) sit atop the league's rebounding charts during their final year on campus.

GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

University of Wisconsin-Parkside senior forward Zygimantas Riauka has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Player of the Week in men's basketball, it was announced by the league office Monday.

Riauka finished the week with two double-doubles, helping two-time defending GLVC East Division Champion Rangers open the conference slate with a pair of road wins. The Downers Grove, Illinois, product netted a team-high 17 points on Friday while securing 14 rebounds in a 77-69 win over Truman State before tallying 17 points and 13 boards in a 77-64 victory at Quincy on Sunday.

Riauka averaged 17.0 points, 13.5 rebounds, and 2.0 blocks per game while dishing out two assists and netting one steal for the week.

This is the second career weekly selection for Riauka as he was the last Ranger to be honored on Jan. 13, 2014.
