2014-15 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

The Return to Intradivision Play

After two straight weeks of playing opponents outside their respective divisions, GLVC men's basketball teams return to familiar competition for the final full week of action. Four GLVC Championship Tournament bids are still up for grabs and two teams fighting to secure their post-season future will battle the West's top teams. Quincy takes the spotlight this week with a Thursday matchup against tournament-bound Missouri-St. Louis and then a Saturday matinee against Maryville, which like the Hawks are fighting to get in. The Saints host second-place Truman State on Thursday. An exciting week is set up for quite the finale as Indianapolis travels to Bellarmine for an 8 p.m. ET tip Saturday in a battle of top-10 teams.

The Week That Was

GLVC men's basketball wrapped up interdivision play Saturday with all three nationally-ranked teams finding the win column against opponents from the West division. Chris Whitehead poured in 30 points to help No. 3 Bellarmine past Missouri-St. Louis, 88-78, while No. 7 Indianapolis and No. 12 UW-Parkside earned wins over Truman State and Drury, respectively. Elsewhere, McKendree's Logan Carson led all scorers on the day with 31 points in the Bearcats' 79-72 win over William Jewell. Bellarmine and UW-Parkside each went 4-0 last week to remain tied atop the East division standings at 14-1, while Drury holds a one-game advantage over Truman State in the West at 10-5 in league play.

Three GLVC Teams Ranked in National Top 25 Poll

Three GLVC teams are ranked in the latest NABC/Division II rankings, which were released Tuesday afternoon. Bellarmine remained at the No. 3 position in this week's poll, while Indianapolis moved from seventh to sixth. UW-Parkside stayed steady at No. 12 in the polls, making this week the highest three teams have been ranked together all year. Lewis is also receiving votes outside the top 25.

GLVC Boasts 7 of 10 Spots in First NCAA Regional Rankings

In the first NCAA Division II Midwest Regional Rankings report released today, the GLVC boasts seven schools among the top 10, including the top three teams. Bellarmine ranks first overall, followed by UW-Parkside and Indianapolis in second and third, respectively, while Lewis, Drury, Southern Indiana and Truman State rank seventh through 10th. The GLIAC's Saginaw Valley State, Lake Superior State and Michigan Tech rank fifth through seventh. The top eight teams in each of the country's eight regions will make the NCAA Tournament when the field is announced next month.

Win and Win Big

Four GLVC programs currently rank among the nation's top 25 in scoring margin, led by Indianapolis with a 20.7 margin of victory. Truman State trails in eighth at 14.0, while UW-Parkside (14.5) and Bellarmine (13.8) are 10th and 22nd.

Sharp Shooters

Four GLVC teams and four conference standouts are ranked among the nation's top 25 in field-goal percentage. Bellarmine (52.7) leads the way in second, followed by Indianapolis (51.0) in seventh, Lewis (49.4) in 20th, and UW-Parkside (49.3) in 22nd. Individually, Bellarmine's Jake Thelen, who led all of Division II in shooting last year, is second this season with a 68.1 shooting percentage. Drury's Cameron Adams (65.2) is sixth, while McKendree's Matt Holmes (59.7) is 21st and Ulndy's Joe Lawson (59.2) is 24th.

Making a Career From the Floor

Ulndy's Brennan McElroy, Bellarmine's Jake Thelen and Drury's Cameron Adams rank in the top six among NCAA Division II active career leaders in field goal percentage. Currently McElroy leads all shooters in NCAA Division I, II and III with a .691 career clip, having made 302 of his 437 attempts in 92 games. Thelen (68.7) is third overall, while Adams (63.5) is sixth. Across all divisions, Thelen remains third and Adams is 10th. Also of note, Lewis' Kyle Nelson is 33rd across all divisions with a 60.6 shooting percentage. From a scoring perspective, Saint Joseph's Cameron Vines is Division II's active career leader with 22.0 points per game.

Lewis Flying High

Coming off another 2-0 conference tilt, Lewis has won its last six straight games, which is the second longest winning streak in the conference right now. The Flyers' wins have come in style of late as Lewis swatted 11 shots against Missouri S&T on Saturday, which was the highest total of blocks by the program in a single game in four years. In Thursday's 76-52 win over Drury, the Flyers snapped a nine-game losing streak against the Panthers. In its last four games, Lewis has held its opponents to under 40 percent shooting from the floor, which has improved the Flyers' field-goal percentage defense mark to 40.4 on the year, ranking 23rd nationally.

GLVC Championship Tournament Tickets on Sale

Tickets for the 2015 GLVC Basketball Championship Tournament went on sale Monday at MetroTix.com. This year's event will be held at Family Arena in St. Charles, Missouri, March 5-8. All-Tournament passes (\$38) along with general admission adult (\$18) and student (\$11) single-session passes are available.

GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Bellarmino University senior guard Chris Whitehead has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Player of the Week for men's basketball, it was announced by the league office Monday.

The New Albany, Indiana, native earns his second career weekly honor, as his first came last Monday following two impressive outings in conference action.

Whitehead turned in another remarkable week of play, averaging 24.5 points on 60 percent shooting (18-of-30), 5.5 assists, 3.5 rebounds per game. He grabbed three steals and committed just two turnovers in 72 minutes of playing time while also having to endure a personal loss which forced him to log hundreds of extra miles on the road.

On Thursday, he led the Knights to an 83-66 win over Maryville by scoring 19 points, grabbing a career high-tying five rebounds and handing out six assists while turning the ball over just once. The senior then made the trip back to Louisville to attend the funeral of his grandmother in nearby New Albany, Indiana, on Friday. Next, he turned around and made the trip back to St. Louis in time for Saturday afternoon's clash with Missouri-St. Louis. Road fatigue was no issue as the 5-9 point guard responded with a career-high 30 points on 11-of-16 shooting and dished out five assists while committing just one turnover in 38 minutes of inspired play in the Knights' 88-78 win.
