2014-15 GLVC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Interdivision Play Returns This Week

GLVC men's basketball returns to the court this week with interdivision play, pitting the East Division squads against the West. Among the featured games this week is co-West leader Truman State (8-3 GLVC) traveling to co-East leader Bellarmine (10-1) and Missouri-St. Louis (7-4) visiting Indianapolis (9-2) on Thursday.

The Week That Was

A week that started with top-ranked Indianapolis and Drury atop the GLVC East and West divisions, respectively, took a wild turn midweek as madness ensued a month early. Thursday's results left a three-way tie for first place in both the East and West, and just two teams remained tied at week's end, not one of them being the No. 1 Greyhounds. No. 20 UW-Parkside upset Ulindy 72-68 in Kenosha Thursday night, giving the Greyhounds their first loss of the season and snapping their 19-game winning streak. No. 6 Bellarmine's 80-60 win over Illinois Springfield also put the Knights into a tie for first place in the East. Truman State earned an 85-81 victory at Drury, and Missouri-St. Louis held on for a 77-76 victory at Rockhurst to put the Bulldogs, Panthers and Tritons atop the GLVC West at 7-3. Among the other headlines Thursday, McKendree defended its home court over Southern Indiana, 88-82, behind 35 points by Logan Carson. On Saturday, Ulindy was upset on the road for the second straight game, falling to Lewis, 70-61. In the West, Drury waited until the final second to maintain its share of the division lead with Truman State as the Panthers beat Quincy with a buzzer-beater heave in a 90-88 overtime thriller.

"Bundy's Bomb" Gone Viral

Despite the big wins by Lewis and UW-Parkside in the GLVC East last week, the Quincy/Drury contest will arguably go down as the most thrilling finish in the GLVC and perhaps in the entire country this season. Trailing 87-85 in overtime, Quincy's Godson Eneogwe grabbed a loose ball near the right corner and hoisted a fall-away three that swished through the net with 1.6 seconds remaining. Following an official review, Drury's Ben Fisher delivered a bullet pass to a sprinting, cutting Kameron Bundy near half-court, who took a couple dribbles and found nothing but net from 40 feet out. "Bundy's Bomb" has since gone viral, having been viewed close to 15,000 times on multiple YouTube channels, while also drawing the national attention of Yahoo Sports and Sporting News, which declared it "the best finish of the college basketball season to date." For the second straight week, Drury rallied from 20 points down in the second half for the win, while Quincy suffered its second buzzer-beating heartbreak of the year, having fallen on a tip-in to Maryville as time expired in a 77-76 loss on Jan. 15.

Three GLVC Teams Ranked in National Top 25 Poll

Three GLVC teams are ranked in the latest NABC/Division II rankings, which were released Tuesday afternoon. Bellarmine continues to climb one spot in the polls, up this week from sixth to fifth overall. Indianapolis dropped from No. 1 to No. 9 after two league losses on the road last week, one of which to UW-Parkside, a team that jumped from 20th to 14th.

Familiar Faces in GLVC's Last Drop From the Top

Ulindy's drop from the top in the national rankings marked the first time since the 2003-04 season that a GLVC team ranked No. 1 in the country suffered two losses prior to the next poll being released. Interestingly enough, No. 1 Southern Indiana's drop in the rankings in 2004 involved Indianapolis as well as Lewis and UW-Parkside, the two teams that stunned the top-ranked Greyhounds last week. Heading into the holiday break, USI was ranked No. 1 in the Dec. 23, 2013 poll, and then resumed GLVC play with three games after the New Year prior to the next national poll released on Jan. 13, 2014. The Screaming Eagles, undefeated at the time at 11-0 and 4-0 in GLVC play, fell at home to Lewis 82-77 on Jan. 2. USI did rebound with a 71-63 win against UW-Parkside on Jan. 4, but suffered an 88-87 defeat at Indianapolis on Jan. 8. The two losses dropped Southern Indiana to 16th in the Jan. 13 poll.

Truman's Jackson First to Forty & First in Free Throws

Truman State's Seth Jackson, the GLVC Player of the Week, became the first conference player to reach the 40-point mark this year, scoring 42 in an 85-81 road win at Drury last Thursday. The last time a GLVC player went for 40 or more points was on Feb. 27, 2014 when Jackson's former teammate Mike Carlson put up 40 against Quincy. What made Jackson's 42 points so impressive last week, was that he was just 7-of-11 from the field. The majority of his points came from the line, netting 25 of his 30 free-throw attempts, both of which are conference records. The 25 makes broke the previous GLVC best of 21 by McKendree's Mike DiGregorio against Missouri S&T on Feb. 8, 2014, while his 30 attempts were four more than the previous league record of 26 set by Southern Indiana's Duron Hebron against former conference foe Kentucky State on Feb. 13, 1993. Also of note, Jackson's point total from free throws alone ranks as the 39th-best scoring output in the GLVC this season.

Bellarmine's Thelen Near Perfect Last Week

Perfection rarely occurs in basketball, but for Bellarmine's Jake Thelen it almost happened on back to back performances on the road. On Thursday, the Bellarmine post player set a new school record by going 10-for-10 from the field in leading Bellarmine with 22 points as the Knights scorched the nets for 66 percent shooting—the best team performance in the GLVC this year. Thelen followed that up with 10 of 11 shooting at McKendree, while recording his ninth double-double of the year with 21 points and 16 rebounds. He even flirted with a triple double by adding six assists. For the week, he shot 95.2 percent from the floor and averaged 21.5 points, nine rebounds, and 4.5 assists per game.

Knights, Rangers First to 10 GLVC Wins

For the first time in four years, two GLVC teams from the same division have reached 10 conference wins by the end of January. Bellarmine and UW-Parkside currently sit atop the East with identical 18-2 records overall and 10-1 marks in league play. The last time two teams in the same division reached 10 GLVC wins this soon in the season was Bellarmine (12-0) and Southern Indiana (10-2) on Jan. 29, 2011.

GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Truman State University senior guard Seth Jackson has been named the Great Lakes Valley Conference Player of the Week for men's basketball, it was announced by the league office Monday.

Jackson averaged 31.0 points on 13-of-21 shooting (61.9 percent), to go along with 7.0 rebounds, and 2.0 assists per game in two road wins against GLVC West-division rivals Drury and Missouri S&T last Thursday and Saturday. The wins helped move the Bulldogs into a first-place tie in the West division, as Truman now holds the second-longest active winning streak in the GLVC at five.

In an 85-81 victory at Drury on Thursday, Jackson registered a career high and GLVC season-high 42 points on 7-of-11 shooting from the field and an impressive 25-of-30 from the free-throw line. He also added seven rebounds, one block, one steal and an assist in the win. His 42 points are tied for the third-most in Truman single-game history, while his 25 made free throws marked the most by a Bulldog in a single-game in nearly 60 years (Dec. 12, 1955). He finished one shy of the all-time FT attempts school-record. GLVC records indicate that both the 21 free throws made and the 26 attempts from the line are new conference records.

In the 96-74 victory at Missouri S&T, Jackson scored 20 points on 6-of-10 shooting, while grabbing seven rebounds and dishing three assists.

The St. Louis, Missouri, native earns his second career weekly honor as he was also recognized earlier this season on Dec. 8, 2014.
