## Web Developer

The ideal candidate for the Web Developer position should be a skilled, full-stack web developer who has expertise in both front-end development and back-end development languages and frameworks, user experience design (UX & UI), and web-based technologies. This position is responsible for the full range of web-based needs common to many small organizations — from implementation and maintenance of stakeholder-driven functionality and existing websites to collaborative formation of website design and data visualizations. As a result, the successful candidate will possess a practical knowledge of website interfacing across multiple platforms using the latest standards, user-centered design, and a talent for innovative, sophisticated interface design.

### Essential Functions:

- Ensure website usability and responsiveness across multiple platforms and browsers.
- Ensure website implements and supports modern accessibility standards.
- Design and implement websites that can communicate complex information in interesting, intuitive, and relevant ways, using interactivity and application-specific features when appropriate.
- Design ongoing tools and methods for conducting audience analysis, web analytics, and formative evaluations.
- Ensure high-quality graphic standards and brand consistency.
- Manage targeted communications through email campaign platforms.
- Design and implement new client-facing, data-driven websites, dashboards, and visualizations.
- Develop, as needed, self-contained web capabilities, such as web-based content that leverages GIS capabilities (ESRI or others), d3 based visualizations, etc.
- Complete small website edits, develop plans for completing larger projects, collaborate with colleagues, and suggest new solutions to improve existing websites.
- Support and troubleshoot occasional problems with our existing website and other dashboards developed and maintained by The Data Center.
- Manage an appropriate security model for all websites and dashboards managed by The Data Center.
- Ensure all plug-ins and certificates are up-to-date for all websites and dashboards managed by The Data Center.

- Create and maintain website and web application documentation.

### **Qualifications:**

- 3-5 years of progressive, professional experience in web design and development.
- Bachelor's or graduate degree in computer science, graphic design, or related field is preferred.
- Proficient in Adobe Creative Suite.
- Working knowledge of HTML, CSS, PHP, Javascript, GIS, data visualization software, and other scripting and programming languages.
- Experience building sites within a CMS, such as Wordpress.
- Experience building dashboards and data visualizations.
- Familiarity with concepts of information design.
- Experience in app development is an asset.
- Proficient understanding of version control tools, such as GIT is an asset.
- The successful candidate will be self-driven and a clear communicator — both written and verbally — and possess an advanced knowledge of current website technologies.
