## GOODWILL SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA OPENS 79th RETAIL STORE – AT FLETCHER SQUARE IN GLASSELL PARK

Los Angeles, CA, April 7, 2014 - Goodwill Southern California (GSC) will celebrate the grand opening of their new flagship retail store and outlet center on Friday, April 11, in Glassell Park / Atwater Village (3150 N. San Fernando Road). The official ribbon cutting ceremony will commence at 8:45 a.m. The retail store and outlet center are part of Goodwill's new Community Enrichment Center at Fletcher Square (opening May 1, 2014), a fully renovated, 135,000 sq. ft. facility which will offer a wide spectrum of programs and services that address the employment, education, health, and universal needs of the community.

Customers are invited to shop a wide selection of everyday values, great fashion, and search for 200 free items throughout the store! There will be an opportunity for shoppers to enjoy drawings for prizes including a new flat screen TV and two Blue-ray players, and for every \$50 spent they will receive a \$5 gift certificate good toward future purchases at Goodwill Southern California retail stores. The first 100 shoppers in line will receive a merchandise voucher for \$10 and the first 1,000 shoppers will receive a free Goodwill tote bag.

GSC's 79<sup>th</sup> store opening in Glassell Park / Atwater Village brings employment opportunities to the community while ninety-three cents of every dollar generated from sales is dedicated to funding GSC's mission to prepare and place individuals with disabilities and other vocational challenges in sustainable employment.
