Goodwill Southern California serves some of the most disadvantaged young people – those whose lives are challenged every day by poverty, high crime, failing schools and broken families. Goodwill's programs help these youth focus on scholastic success, acquire vocational skills and obtain employment. Because of our intervention, many youth have gone on to college and found good jobs.

Last year, Goodwill served youth at locations in **Northeast Los Angeles, Pomona** and **Victorville**. We also launched an exciting leadership development program called **Young 'N LA** for minority youth who have been, or are currently, on probation. These vital programs make it possible for us to help a struggling teen mother finish high school, a young man on probation train for and get a decent job, or a promising student take their SAT and enroll in college.

Our no cost programs and services place young adults in internships, job-readiness training and employment positions with businesses throughout our community. We help youth develop the skills, get the experience and build the relationships they need to succeed. We also offer a host of additional supportive services when necessary such as work uniforms, gas reimbursements, bus passes, work tools, book reimbursements and educational fees.
