An average adult heart is a little larger than a closed fist, weighs about 11 ounces (roughly the same weight as a large turnip), and despite what we see on greeting cards, it feels more like an upside-down pera than a Valentine's Day. According to the American Heart Association, the heart beats an average of 100,000 times a day -- 60 to 100 beats per minute -- which equates to more than 2.5 billion beats when we're 70. What makes your heart beat? Electricity. But before we understand what electricity is doing in the body, we need to first understand the parts of the heart and how they work together. The heart has four rooms, two upper and two lower. The upper chambers are called left and right atria, and the lower two are the left and right ventricles. A valve connects each atrium with its corresponding ventricle. The tricuspid valve connects the right atrium and ventricle, and the mitral valve connects the left atrium and ventricle. Two additional valves complete the set: the pulmonary valve connects the right ventricle with the pulmonary artery, and the aortic valve connects the left ventricle with the aorta. These four valves act as gates, allowing blood to flow in one direction with each heartbeat -- about 2,000 gallons of blood every day. So what's the power source to keep this system running - and your heart beats? The heart beats due to a small electric current generated by the cardiac conduction system. The cardiac conduction system is a group of muscle cells in the walls of the heart. It consists of five main components: the synoatrial node (SA node): known as the heart pacemaker, this node activates at regular intervals, causing the heart to blink. The atrioventricular node (AV node): the electric relay station between the upper and lower cardiac chambers. The His beam (also known as the atrioventricular beam): muscle fibers that conduct the electrical impulses that regulate the heartbeat. Beam branches: Connected to the bundle of His, these lead to the lower ventricles. Purkinje fibers: Incorporated into the subendotelial tissue, these fibers conduct impulses through the heart. When all these components work together as they should, you have a healthy heart with a beat rate of about 60-70 beats per minute or higher, depending on your age and other factors. Blige's Not Gon' Cry, a story about a broken-hearted wife, were written by a man, Babyface. Blige sings: While all the time I loved you, you were busy loving yourself. I'd stop breathing if I told myself. Now you're busy loving someone else. Eleven years after my life, besides children, I have nothing to show. Wasted my years a fool of a wife, I should have left your rod a long time ago. Toni Braxton's best moment as a singer came when she managed to emotionally reach the low minimum in Un-Break My Heart. The text begs an ex-lover to come back and undo the pain they caused. Braxton's version was so powerful that it won a Grammy Award for Best Female Pop Vocal Performance. Sadly, Amy Winehouse's deep blue Back To Black is tragically autobiographical. The song is about going into a deep depression after being left for an ex. He left no time to kept her (thing) wet with her own old safe bet, sings sadly Winehouse. Alice Russell, one of the UK's best soul singers, has released Heartbreaker Heartbreaker end of 2012.
