
HOLY-WEEK SERVICES




Palm Sunday | March 24, 9:30am

Palm Sunday is the service at which we remember both Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem and his trial and crucifixion. At this service of Holy Eucharist, we remember that Christ wears two crowns: one a jeweled crown as King of Heaven and Earth, and one a thorny crown as savior of the world.



Maundy Thursday | March 28, 6pm

On Maundy Thursday, we remember the last supper Jesus had with his disciples. On the night before he was arrested, Jesus instituted Holy Communion, a celebration that the church has carried forward ever since.



Good Friday | March 29, 6pm

On Good Friday, we will read the story of Jesus' passion, confess our sins, and hear the Word preached. At no time is the weight of God's holiness and law felt more powerfully than on this night. But even as our savior dies on the cross, we know that resurrection and new life wins in the end.



Easter Sunday | March 31, 9:30am

The most joyous feast of the Christian year, Easter Sunday is our celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead and final victory over sin, securing eternal life for us forever. We will sing his praises, read his word, proclaim his Good News, and feast together on his body and blood, broken and shed for us.
