Introduction: There is no {Gospel} without the resurrection (*I Corinthians 15:17-19*).
How can we be confident of Jesus’ resurrection? (*I Peter 3:15*)

I. THE EMPTY {TOMB}

**Luke 24:1-11 *John 19:38-40 *John 20:6-7 *Luke 24:37-43*

Note: There have been many {lies} about the empty tomb.

II. THE RESURRECTION {APPEARANCES}

**I Corinthians 15:5-8 *John 20:19 *Acts 1:1-3 *Acts 1:9-10*

Note: The way Jesus returned to Heaven is significant: {Ascension}.

III. THE CHANGE OF THE {DAY OF WORSHIP}

**Psalm 118:24 *Revelation 1:10 *Matthew 28:1 *Acts 2:1*

**John 20:19 *Acts 20:7 *I Corinthians 16:2*

Note: Most of the first believers were {Jews}.

IV. THE CHANGE IN HIS {FOLLOWERS}

**John 2:19-22 *John 20:1-2 *Mark 16:9-14 *John 20:24-28*

Conclusion: A person {must} believe and confess the resurrection of Jesus
to be saved (*Romans 10:9*).
