It is filled with spiritual significance (I Corinthians 5:7 / I Corinthians 10:11).

I. THE **{SACRIFICE}**

1. It must be a **{lamb}**.
2. It must be a **{male}**.
3. It must be **{unblemished}**.
4. It must be **{slain}**.
5. It must be **{applied}**.

II. THE **{SIGNIFICANCE}**

*Exodus 12:12-13 *Exodus 12:28-30 *Romans 6:23 *John 3:36
*Exodus 12:31-36 *John 14:6 *John 10:9-10

1. It protected from **{death}**.
2. It was the passport to **{abundant life}**.

God made the **{Lord's Supper}** a memorial (I Corinthians 11:23-26).
