

Lesson 5: Walking in Love

Reggie Coe, Marriage and Senior Adults Pastor

- I. The Focus to Love One Another: Loving others reflects the intimacy we have with the Lord who sent His Son to give us life—1 John 4:7–9.
- **II.** The Source of Love for One Another: God's love for us provides us with the capacity to love others the way He loves us—1 John 4:10–11.
- **III.** The Standard of Love for One Another: Christ directed us to love one another in the same way He loves us—*John 13:34–35*.
- **IV.** The Ability to Have Love for One Another: We demonstrate His quality of love for others as we abide in Him—John 15:4–5.

Walking in love is loving others in the same way Christ loves us unconditionally and sacrificially. We do that by abiding in Him.

Takeaways:

- 1. We love others with Christ-like love when we accept one another and avoid being judgmental and condemning of others.
- 2. We love others with Christ-like love when we invest in others with care and compassion.
- 3. We love others with Christ-like love when we walk with them through their difficult periods.
