Introduction to 1 John Τ.

Jesus is the abundant life. Abiding is how we experience the abundant life.

1 John 1:1 II.

John begins by anchoring his message on the apostles' eyewitness account of the incarnation of Jesus.

1 John 1:2 III.

Beholding Jesus as life itself leads the apostles to share the hope of life in Him.

1 John 1:3 IV.

The believers who were the audience of this epistle are invited to join in fellowship with the apostles and with the Father and Son.

1 John 1:4 v.

While there are 5 purpose statements throughout 1 John, 1:3–4 provide the overarching purpose of John's writing: joy is found in fellowship with God and others.
