Mission is a town of 45,000 people situated on the Rio Grande. It is the home of Hall of Fame football coach Tom Landry and a large-scale producer of Ruby Red grapefruit. Of its 13,000 households, one in four lives below the poverty line.

Cost to participate is \$800, including bus fare and meals in Mission.

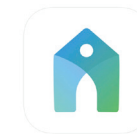


WELCOME

MESSAGE | 2 PETER 2:10B–17

Be Diligent Lesson 4, The Conduct of False Teachers

- I. **Their Arrogance:** They are pompous in all that they do—*2 Peter 2:10b–12*.
- A. Brazen lifestyle: daring, intentional pursuit of self-centeredness—*2 Peter 10b*
 - B. Superiority complex: audacity to slander celestial beings—*2 Peter 2:10c-12*
- II. **Their Drive:** They are driven by a trained self-centeredness—*2 Peter 2:13–16*.
- A. Wild revelry: don’t attempt to hide their practices even in the daytime—*2 Peter 2:13*
 - B. Sexual perversion: insatiable desires, all they see—*2 Peter 2:14a*
 - C. Selfish greed: never have enough, have become experts at practicing greed—*2 Peter 2:14b–16*
- III. **Their reality:** They are deceivers awaiting judgment—*2 Peter 2:17*.
- A. Inability to produce: cannot provide what they promise—*2 Peter 2:17a*
 - B. Judgment is coming: utter darkness awaits—*2 Peter 2:17b*

Have you ever gone through a process of deconstructing your faith? What did that look like?
