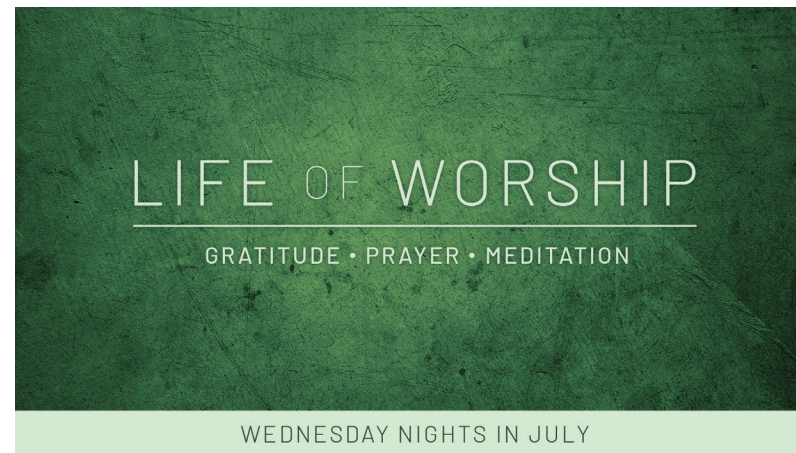

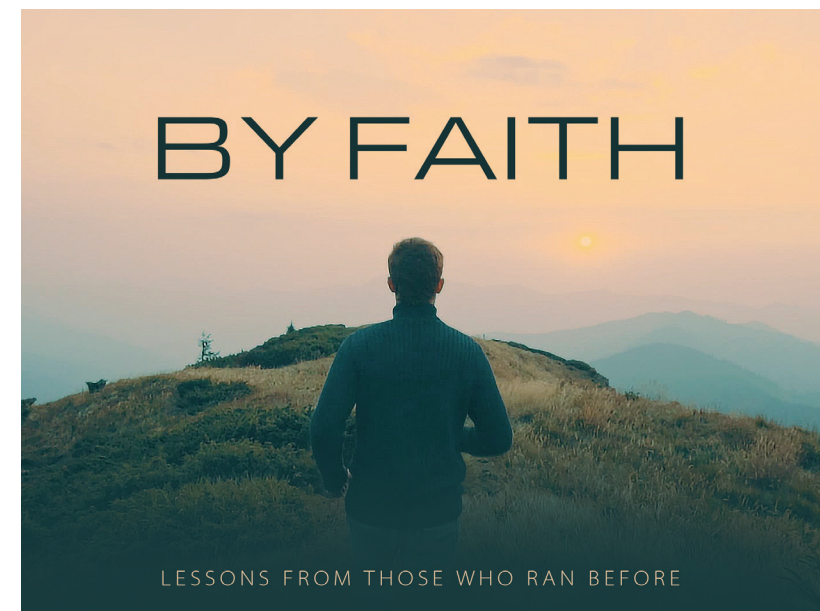
Night of Worship, July 27

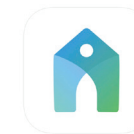


WELCOME

MESSAGE | HEBREWS 11:1–6

By Faith, Week 1: The Heart of Faith

- I. The Description of Faith—*Hebrews 11:1–3*.
 - A. Living out one’s faith is the conviction that God will bring about the things that He has said He will do—*Hebrews 11:1*.
 - B. The Scriptures are filled with examples of men and women who are commended for living according to their faith—*Hebrews 11:2*.
 - C. Faith provides the way of understanding life in both looking back and looking forward—*Hebrews 11:3*.
- II. Consider Abel and a Better Sacrifice—*Hebrews 11:4*.
 - A. New Testament believers, like Abel, enjoy a better sacrifice (*cf. Genesis 4:4*).
 - B. The difference between Abel’s and Cain’s sacrifice is found in the integrity of Abel’s heart in the offering (*cf. Genesis 4:3, 5–7*).
- III. Consider Enoch and Pleasing God—*Hebrews 11:5*.
 - A. Enoch modeled a life characterized by faith and never experienced death (*cf. Genesis 5:21–24*).
 - B. There will be a generation of believers who will experience this same kind of transition into the Lord’s presence (*cf. 1 Thessalonians 4:15–17*).
- IV. Walking by Faith—*Hebrews 11:6*.
 - A. The disciple who lives by faith honors the Lord—*Hebrews 11:6a*.
 - B. Faith begins with believing God exists—*Hebrews 11:6b*.
 - C. Faith involves the disciple believing that God rewards the faithful—*Hebrews 11:6c*.
