Bible Study | HIS RESURRECTION & ASCENSION

- The Resurrection culminates the passion narrative in all four Gospels 1 Corinthians 15:12–19
 - A. Without the Resurrection, Christ would still be dead,
 - B. The gospel would be meaningless,
 - c. Faith in Christ would be worthless,
 - D. All who claim resurrection would be liars,
 - E. All would still be lost in sin,
 - F. Former believers would be eternally lost, and
 - G. Christianity would be pointless and pitiable
- II. The Resurrection was confirmed by evidence and testimonies— 1 Corinthians 15:1–11
 - A. Because of the Resurrection, the gospel is validated,
 - B. The church was established,
 - c. The Scriptures are true,
 - D. There were eyewitnesses, including Paul's own testimony
- III. The Ascension of Jesus Christ to right hand of the Father enabled Him to perform subsequent ministries
 - A. He sent the Holy Spirit John 16:5–7
 - B. He is the head of the church Colossians 1:18–20
 - c. He is preparing a place for us John 14:1–3
 - D. He is our High Priest Hebrews 4:14–16
