Bible Study | HIS FUTURE MINISTRIES

- Jesus will Restore Life: Christ will resurrect everyone, believers to life and T. unbelievers to death — John 5:25–29
 - **Q** *Iohn* 3:18, 6:28; *Revelation* 20:6
 - The Rapture: Christ will return for the church and transform them A. into glorified bodies fit for eternity — 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
 - ¶ 1 Thessalonians 5:9: 1 Corinthians 15:51–53: 2 Peter 3:9
 - Second Coming: The believers who died before the Church Age B. ("Old Testament saints") and those who died during the Tribulation will be resurrected at Christ's Second Coming — Matthew 24:29–42
 - Revelation 20:4
 - Unbelievers' Resurrection: At the end of the Millennial Kingdom, C. after Satan has been vanquished, Christ will raise the unsaved dead and bring them to the Great White Throne — Revelation 20:11–12
- II. Jesus will Restore Justice: The Father has given all authority to the Son, who will judge both believers and unbelievers — John 5:22
 - The Judgment Seat of Christ: After the Rapture, Christ will Α. individually judge each believer on the basis of how they lived for Christ during their time on earth — 1 Corinthians 3:11–15
 - 2 Corinthians 5:10
 - Judgment of Sheep and Goats: At the Second Coming, those B. who have come to faith in Christ during the Tribulation will be permitted to enter the Kingdom. Those who rejected Christ will be judged — Matthew 25:31-40
 - Great White Throne: This judgment involves only unbelievers, and C. all will see that their deeds did not earn them eternal life because they had not trusted Christ as Savior — Revelation 20:12-15
 - Q John 5:24; Ezekiel 33:11
- Iesus will Restore Creation: Christ will restore and rule the world III. throughout eternity future in the New Heavens and the New Earth — Revelation 21:1-6
