
Sunday Morning

Discussion Questions

- I. If you've had a life-changing, personal encounter with Jesus, who are the people around you who you'd want to experience that encounter as well? How can your personal encounter with Jesus be helpful or encouraging to others?
- **II.** God often leads people away from distraction and out "into the wilderness" so that He can speak more clearly to them. Where can you see God inviting you away from distraction so that He can speak more clearly to you, and so that you can rest in Him?
- **III.** God doesn't use formulas for dealing with individual people. No two lives are the same in His eyes. How is He using your unique experiences to shape you right now?
- **IV.** Perhaps you've found yourself frustrated that you weren't "as far along" as you think you should be in your faith. In what ways do you think God may be working on you—teaching you and growing you—exactly where you are right now?
- **V.** By contrast, have you ever found yourself in a state of laziness or apathy because you think you're as mature as you need to be at the moment? Do you believe right now that you still need God every bit as much today as you did when you began your journey of faith? How might God be challenging that notion where you are at this time?
- **VI.** In Philippians 3:14, Paul wrote of the prize on which he was focused, and which enabled him to endure hardships, knowing that God's work in him was not yet complete. Where has God given you glimpses of His glory to encourage you and remind you of His greater purposes for your struggles? What reminders can you look to around you right now for that encouragement?
