- **Lesson 1: Grace in Both Testaments** Tom Rodgers, Lead Pastor I. The God of the Hebrew Scriptures: The God of the Older Testament is the same God as the New Testament in being holy, righteous, gracious, merciful, slow to anger, and abundant in kindness—Nehemiah 9:5-38. Understanding "grace": God's grace (unmerited or unearned favor) flows out of His character and is not technically a separate, divine attribute. III. "Grace" in Torah: Since the Mosaic Covenant proceeded from God's character, it would logically include His grace toward the nation Israel. A. The Mosaic Law was not designed to provide personal salvation, and in fact, exposed human sin and the need for redemption—*Romans 7:7b–12*. The Mosaic Law pointed the way to the enjoyment of God's blessings in the Promised Land—Deuteronomy 6:1-3. **C.** The New Covenant has superseded the Mosaic Covenant, so we still learn from it, although we are not under it. IV. "Grace" in Jesus Christ: The fullest display of God's grace was in the person of the Son of God incarnate—John 1:14, 16–17.
