Lesson 6: Grace in Decision Making

The grace of God transforms our decision-making process into an opportunity to experience freedom (*Genesis 2:16–17*).

- I. As we learn to obey God's commands, we experience the freedom of knowing we are honoring Him (*1 Thessalonians 5:16–18*).
- II. As we begin to seek biblical wisdom, we experience the freedom of choosing what is best for us (*Acts 15:1–29*).
- III. As we grow to trust in God's sovereignty, we experience the freedom of resting in whatever the future holds (*Daniel 4:1–37*).

Biblical Decision Making

1. Where God commands, we must obey.
2. Where there is no command, God gives us freedom, responsibility, and wisdom to choose.
3. When we have chosen what is moral and wise, we trust the sovereign God to work all the details together for good.
