
For Men and Women this Fall

Lesson 9: Grace Toward Those who are Outside

- I. A Grace Approach Toward Ourselves: Our view of ourselves rests in the fact that we all come to the Lord in response to His grace—Ephesians 2:8–9.
- **II.** A Grace Approach Toward Others: We live in a fallen world with fallen people and have the opportunity to show them the grace that God has shown us.
 - **A.** Our perspective of others: Our God loves everyone and desires each person to receive eternal life—*John 3:16–17; 2 Peter 3:9*.
 - **B.** Our message to others: We trust Christ to give us wisdom in relating to and speaking to those outside of the faith—*Colossians 4:5–6; 1 Peter 3:15*.
 - **C. Our approach toward others:** Relating to those outside of the faith requires that we lay down our rights in order to come alongside of them in a way that touches their lives—1 Corinthians 9:19–23.
 - **D.** Our compassion toward others: The Lord wants us to do good to everyone, regardless of where they are in relationship to Him—*Galatians 6:10*.
 - **E.** Our refusal to judge others: We are called to evaluate our own lives and not to be judgmental toward others—*Matthew 7:1–5; 1 Corinthians 5:13*.
