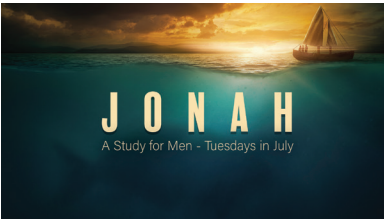

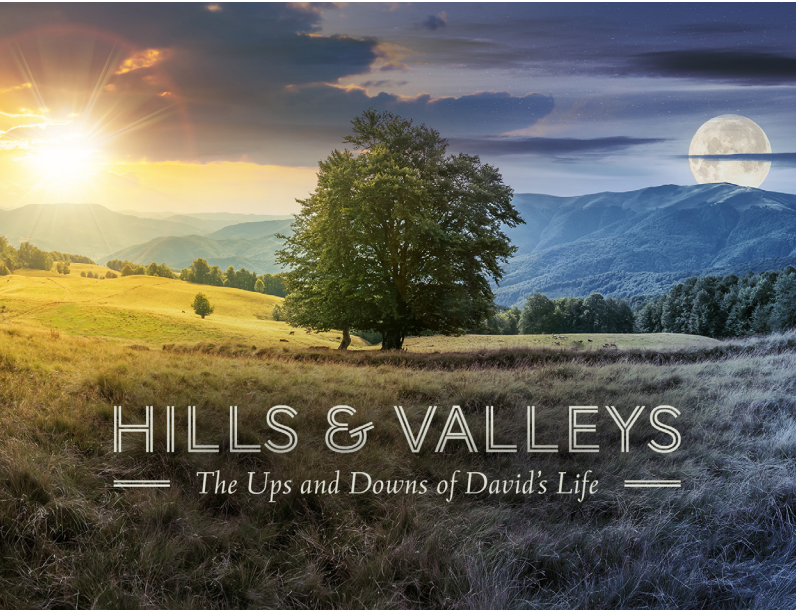

Lesson 2: Giant Distractions

- I. The Giant—*1 Samuel 17:1–11*
 - A. The giant’s stature distracts everyone’s attention—*1 Samuel 17:1–7.*
 - B. The giant’s challenge has everyone afraid—*1 Samuel 17: 8–11.*

 - B. The battle ends with action—*1 Samuel 17: 48–58.*
