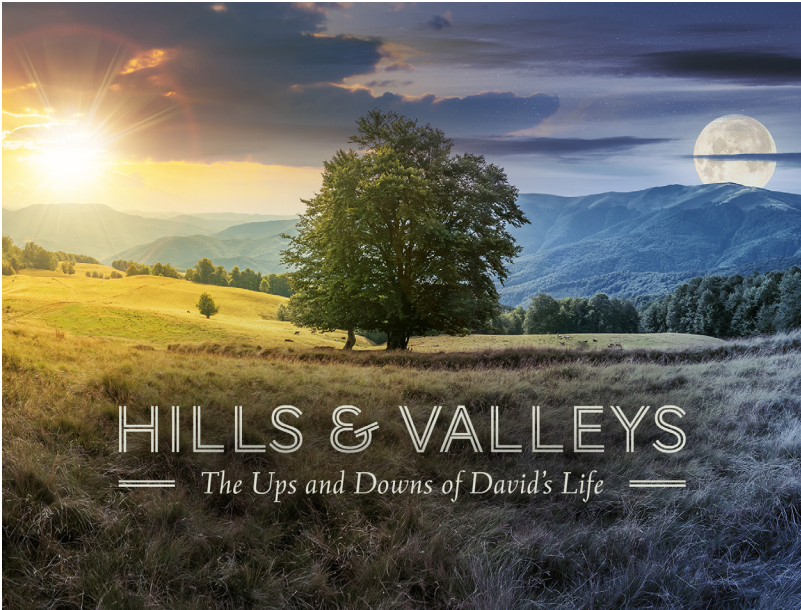

Lesson 5: Are We There Yet?

- I. **Destination Signs:** After receiving news of King Saul’s death, the path to the throne of Israel would have seemed wide open to David—*2 Samuel 2:1–7*.
- II. **Detour Signs:** Abner builds a coalition among the tribes and installs Ishbosheth as king, creating an obstacle to David’s ultimate destination—*2 Samuel 2:8–11*.
- III. **Danger Signs:** After a bloody battle between Abner and Joab, a long and dangerous civil war erupts between Israel and Judah—*2 Samuel 2:12–3:1*.
