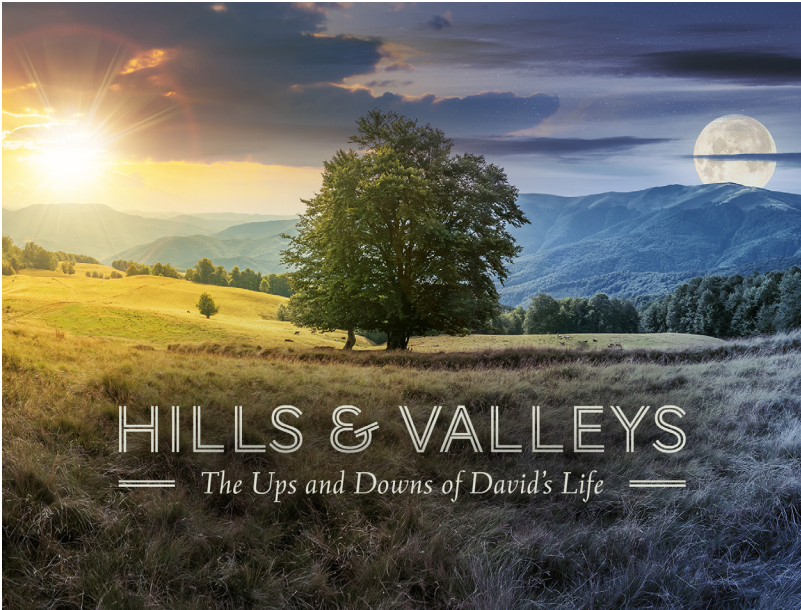

**Lesson 6: The Shepherd King**  
Joe Cook, Pastor to Middle Adults

- I. **The Flock is United:** The Shepherd King is recognized as the rightful king of all Israel based on his kinship, merit, and divine appointment—*2 Samuel 5:1–5*.
- II. **The Flock is Established:** The Shepherd King establishes a new capital at Jerusalem—*2 Samuel 5:6–16*.
- III. **The Flock is Protected:** The Shepherd King’s greatest strength is revealed in his prayerful and obedient handling of Philistine aggression—*2 Samuel 5:17–25*.
