Where do I learn more about Grace Church? FOR SENIOR ADULTS @ 1:00 PM

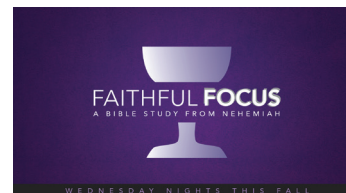
We gather every Tuesday afternoon to study God's Word and reconnect with each other. We'll be studying the book of 1 John together this semester.

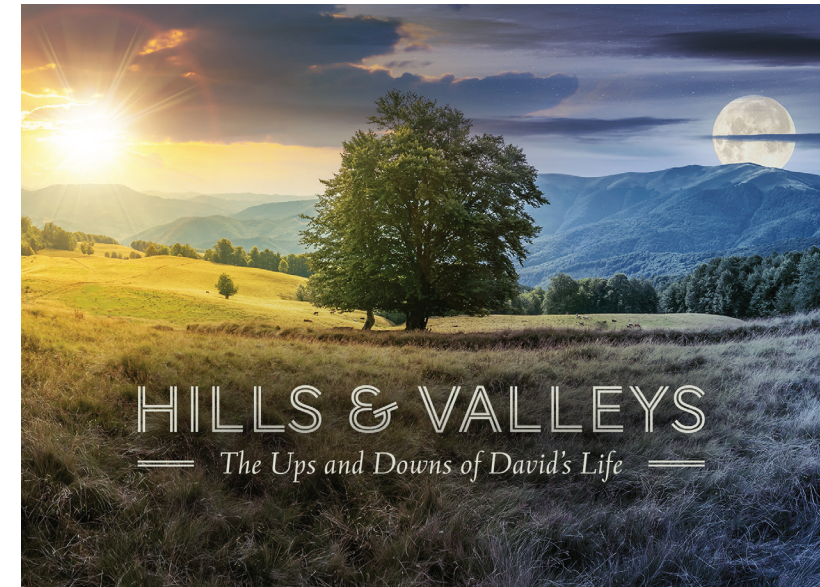
CHRISTIAN HOME TRACK &

MESSAGE | 2 SAMUEL 24

Lesson 12: A Sinful Census

- I. David’s Sin—*2 Samuel 24:1-9*
 - A. David ordered Joab to number the army—*2 Samuel 24:1-3*.
 - B. David ignored Joab’s counsel and proceeded with the census—*2 Samuel 24:4-9*.
- II. David’s Confession—*2 Samuel 24:10-14*
 - A. David recognized his sin and foolishness which gave way to guilt—*2 Samuel 24:10*.
 - B. The Lord offered David the opportunity to choose his discipline—*2 Samuel 24:11-13*.
 - C. David chose to allow God to determine the appropriate discipline and entrusted himself to God’s mercy—*2 Samuel 24:14*.
- III. David’s Punishment—*2 Samuel 24:15-17*
 - A. The Lord chose to send a pestilence that claimed 70,000 lives—*2 Samuel 24:15*.
 - B. The Lord mercifully ended the pestilence before it took Jerusalem—*2 Samuel 24:16*.
 - C. David confessed his personal sin and interceded for his people—*2 Samuel 24:17*.
- IV. David’s Repentance—*2 Samuel 24:18-25*
 - A. The Lord instructed David to build an altar—*2 Samuel 24:18-24*.
 - B. The Lord mercifully responded to David’s offerings—*2 Samuel 24:25*.
