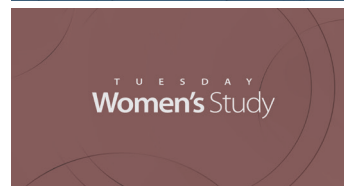

Choose an early morning or evening time to come join this great group of guys for study and prayer. Join us as we begin a new study of the Gospel of Mark.



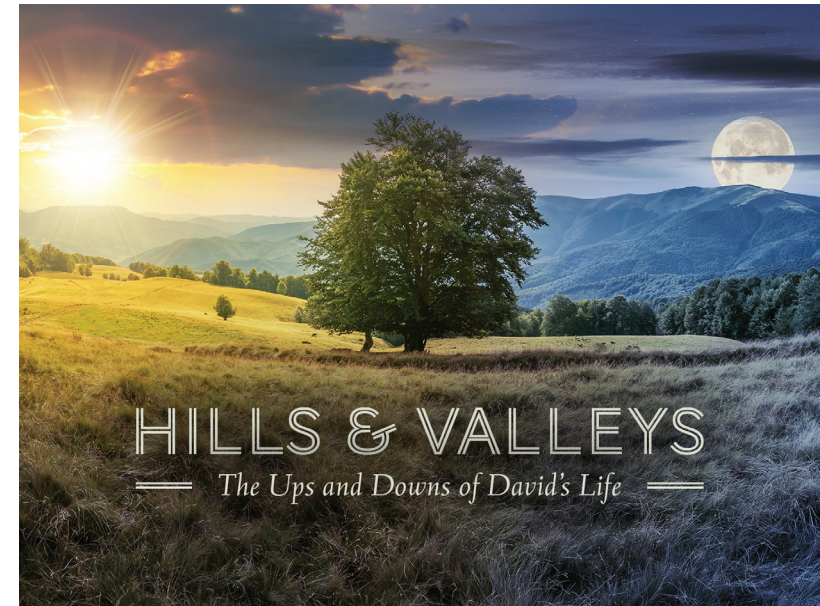
FOR WOMEN @ 10:00 AM or 6:30 PM
