KIDS AND FAMILIES

Sunday mornings now include time for your children to join you in worship and learn what it means to be part of our church family. Nursery care is available all morning long for little ones not yet attending school.

8:00 AM: Kids in Pre-K and up join their families for the entire worship service.

9:30 AM: Kids of all ages attend a Bible Fellowship during Connecting Hour, and should be picked up promptly before the next service.

10:45 AM: Kids in Pre-K and up begin the worship service with their families and stay until parents take them to an age-appropriate Bible lesson for grades 3 and under (after about 20 minutes). Grades 4 and up stay in worship with their family.

Palm Sunday: The Gift of a King

I. **Help is Needed:** World history makes it clear humanity needs help.
Fortunately, from the earliest pages of Scripture, God has promised to send
the help that is needed.

A. Help is promised—*Genesis 12:3*

B. Help will come as a King—*1 Chronicles 17:11–12, Isaiah 9:6:7, Micah 4:3*

II. **Help Arrives:** When the help that was promised arrived, the initial response
was one of excitement. However, expectations do not always match reality.

A. The Gift revealed—*Matthew 21:1–11*

B. The Gift rejected—*John 1:9–11*
