KIDS AND FAMILIES

Sunday mornings include times for your children to join you in worship and learn what it means to be part of our church family. At other times, there are learning opportunities designed especially for them. Nursery care for little ones not yet attending school is available during 9:30 and 10:45 activities.

8:00 AM: Kids worship with their family in the Chapel through the entire service.

9:30 AM: Kids of all ages can participate in children's groups during Connecting Hour and should be picked up promptly before the 10:45 service begins. 4th and 5th grades meet upstairs in the loft.

10:45 AM: Kids in Pre-K through third grade begin in the worship service with their families and stay until parents take them to an age-appropriate Bible lesson around 11:05. Grades 4 and up stay in worship with their family through the entire service.

Note: *Pre-registration is currently required for nursery care due to social distancing capacity limits. If you're visiting today, though, please inquire at the check-in table about remaining space that may be available for your children!*

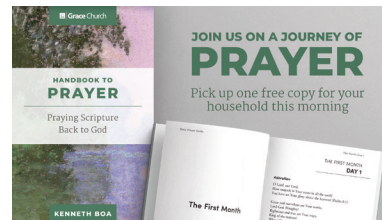

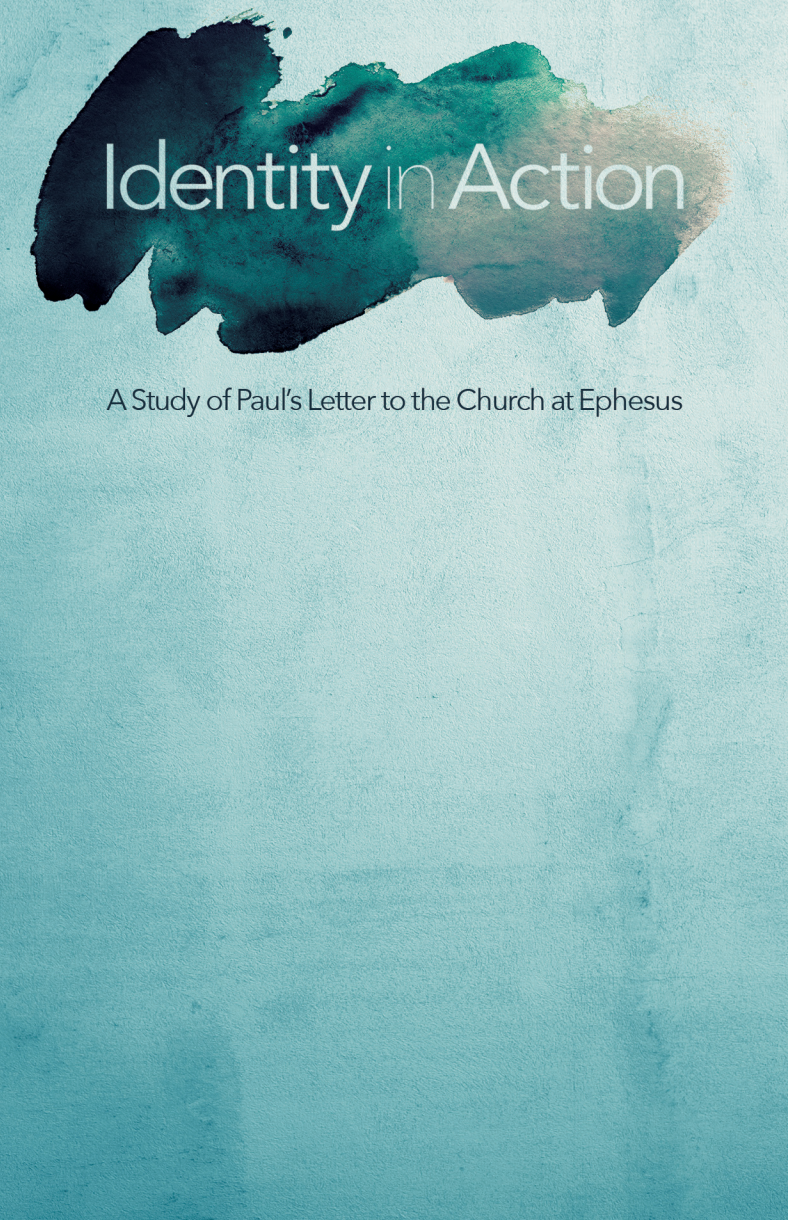

MESSAGE | EPHESIANS 4:25–32

Lesson 11: Exhortations Based on the New Self
Lance Bourgeois, Senior Pastor

- I. **Speak the Truth**—*Ephesians 4:25 (ESV)*

A. Negative: Do not be deceptive.

B. Positive: Tell the truth.

C. Reason: Because we belong to one another
- II. **Deal with Anger**—*Ephesians 4:26–27*

A. Negative: Do not sin in your anger.

B. Positive: Be angry at the right things, in the right way.

C. Reason: Because unresolved anger can lead to further sin
- III. **Do the Work**—*Ephesians 4:28*

A. Negative: Do not steal.

B. Positive: Invest yourself in honest, hard work.

C. Reason: So that we have something to share with those in need
- IV. **Build Up Others**—*Ephesians 4:29–30*

A. Negative: Do not speak “rotten” words.

B. Positive: Use words that are helpful and beneficial to others.

C. Reason: So that your speech will benefit others
- V. **Live in Community**—*Ephesians 4:31–32*

A. Negative: Do not respond to others using these 6 vices (bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, slander, malice).

B. Positive: Practice responding to others using these 3 virtues (kindness, tenderness, forgiveness).

C. Reason: Because Christ forgave you
