Bible Study JOEL 1:1-20

- **Joel's Authority:** The prophet explicitly states that his subsequent message I. originates from Yahweh, the covenantal name of God. This attribution validates all the pronouncements that follow — Joel 1:1
 - Further Reference: Deuteronomy 28:1–4; 2 Samuel 7:16; Jeremiah 30:9

Joel's Message: The prophet reviews in detail the recent catastrophic event II. and invites his audience to take inventory of their losses — Joel 1:2–12

- Joel's Exhortation: The prophet implores the nation to seek God's mercy III. in response to these tragic events — Joel 1:13–20
