

MESSAGE | GALATIANS 5:1-12

Lesson 10: Three Exhortations for the Faithful

- Resist allowing legalism to creep back into their spiritual lives— Galatians 5:1–6.
 - **A. Struggle:** Believers must battle against every pull to return to legalism—*Galatians 5:1*.
 - B. Avoid: Believers must resist any call to reject the freedom offered by Christ—Galatians 5:2–3.
 - C. Sever: Believers who reject the freedom offered by Christ will experience spiritual powerlessness—Galatians 5:4.
 - **D. Hope:** Believers are encouraged by the Spirit as we eagerly await the coming of Christ—*Galatians 5:5.*
 - **E.** Reality: Believers express their maturing faith in love—*Galatians 5:6.*
- **II.** Recognize those who would seek to influence them away from grace—*Galatians 5:7–9.*
 - A. Enemies: Believers must be on guard against anyone who attempts to lead them away from the beautiful, simple truth of the Gospel—Galatians 5:7–8.
 - **B.** Contaminated: Believers can erode their relationship with the Lord anytime they make allowances for legalism—*Galatians 5:9.*
- **III.** Remain fixed on the beautiful, simple truth of the Gospel—Galatians 5:10–12.
 - **A. With the Lord:** Believers must remain focused on the beautiful simple truth of the Gospel—*Galatians 5:10.*
 - B. With the Cross: Believers must remain focused on the finished work of Jesus Christ—Galatians 5:11.
 - C. With the Gospel: Believers must separate themselves from those who would seek to reintroduce legalism into their spiritual life— Galatians 5:12.
