

## This Morning

#### Lesson 12: Woman at the Well—John 4:1-42

Reggie Coe, Marriage & Senior Adults Pastor

- **I.** Jesus left Judea as the Pharisees became more aware of His ministry and went to Samaria— John 4:1–6.
  - **A.** Christ's ministry began to overshadow John the Baptist's ministry in terms of the people's response—John 4:1–3.
  - **B.** Christ needed to go through Samaria because the Father had important work for Him there—*John 4:4–6; see John 5:30.*
- **II.** In His conversation with the Samaritan woman, Christ offered eternal life which quenches the longings of a thirsty life—*John 4:7–26*.
  - **A.** Typically a Jewish Rabbi would not have a conversation with a woman, especially a Samaritan woman—*John 4:7–9.*
  - **B.** Christ's offer of living water only confused this woman—*John 4:10–12*.
  - C. Christ offered her water that would provide her with the life quenching experience of eternal life—John 4:13–14.
  - **D.** Christ focused on this woman's immoral attempt to quench the thirst of her soul through multiple relationships because He knew her history—*John 4:15–18; see John 2:25*.
  - **E.** He directed her attention away from the ritual of worship to the true worship of God, which centers on spiritually connecting with Him from the heart—*John 4:19–24*.
  - **F.** Christ declared Himself to be the Messiah, which the woman embraced and eventually went and told the men of the city about the One she met at the well—*John 4:25–26; see 4:28–29.*
- **III.** In His conversation with His disciples, the Messiah offered them the life sustaining food of doing the Father's will by joining Him in His harvest—*John 4:27–42*.
  - **A.** Christ pointed His disciples to the food of working in His Father's harvest of lives— John 4:27–38.
  - **B.** The Samaritans came to trust in Him as their Messiah because of the woman's words and the witness of Christ—John 4:39–42.
