

Lesson 16: Feeding 5,000 and Walking on Water—John 6:1-21 In the wilderness Christ provided food for people when conventional solutions failed— John 6:1-14 **A.** The upcoming Passover provided the backdrop for this miracle—John 6:1-4 Christ tested Philip and the Twelve by getting them to consider how they could meet the need for food for so many people—John 6:5-7 • Christ had provided wine for the wedding in Cana of Galilee in John 2:1-11 and provided health for the lame man in John 5:1-8 • Christ gave His disciples the opportunity to affirm their confidence in His ability to meet this need—John 6:5-6 • Philip's answer demonstrated that they only looked to their own resources and not to Him—John 6:7 Andrew found a young boy with five barley loaves and two fish and expressed doubt that such a meager provision could meet the need—John 6:8–9 Christ took the five loaves and the two fishes and fed the multitude—John 6:10-14 • Counting only the men, the size of the multitude was five thousand—John 6:10 Christ provided for each person (maybe as many as twelve thousand five hundred including men, woman and children) as much as each wanted—John 6:11 · Christ instructed the disciples to collect the uneaten fragments which filled up twelve baskets, one for each disciple—John 6:12–13 • The multitude stated the parallel between Christ and Moses by saying that He fulfilled Moses's statement in Deuteronomy 18:15—John 6:14 II. Christ walks on water in the midst of the storm, demonstrating His authority over threatening elements—John 6:15-21 **A.** The people wanted to make Christ their king for the wrong reasons—John 6:15; see John 6:26 **B.** The twelve got into a boat to cross the Sea of Galilee to go to Capernaum when a storm came up—John 6:16-18 C. When Christ came toward them, walking on the sea in the midst of the storm, they were frightened—John 6:19
