



# **This Morning**

**Lesson 26: Contrasting Unbelief with Heart-motivated Worship**—*John 11:46–12:11* Reggie Coe, Marriage & Senior Adults Pastor

- **I.** Some who witnessed the raising of Lazarus told the unbelieving Jewish leaders who intensified their plans to kill Jesus—*John11:46–53*.
  - **A.** Even as they admitted His miracles, fear of losing their power and position motivated the Jewish leadership to want to silence Christ—John 11:46–48.
  - **B.** Caiaphas articulated the reality that Christ would have to die to protect the nation—*John 11:49–50.*
  - C. The Lord sovereignly used Caiaphas's words to prophesy that Christ would die for the nation—John 11:51–52.
  - **D.** The Jewish leaders sought an opportune time to kill Christ—*John 11:53*.
- **II.** Christ left Judea while the leaders sought to see if anyone saw Him in Jerusalem—

  John 11:54–57.
- III. Jesus returned to Bethany during the week leading up to Passover—John 12:1–8.
  - **A.** Christ returned to Bethany and made it His headquarters for the week of Passover—

    John 12:1.
  - **B.** At the home of Simon the Leper there was a banquet honoring Christ—*John 12:2*; see Mark 14:3.
  - **C.** Mary knelt before Christ's feet and anointed them with expensive perfume—*John 12:3*; see Mark 14:3.
  - **D.** Judas objected to such extravagance which was motivated by his greed—John 12:4-6.
  - **E.** Christ rebuked Judas and praised Mary's expression of devoted worship to Him John 12:7–8.
- **IV.** Many who knew that He had raised Lazarus believed in Him, which made the Jewish authorities plot to kill Lazarus as well—*John 12:9–11*.
