Bring your favorite salad or dessert to share as we fellowship and learn together. Reconnect with friends and learn about what's next in our women's ministry. Reserve your spot today!



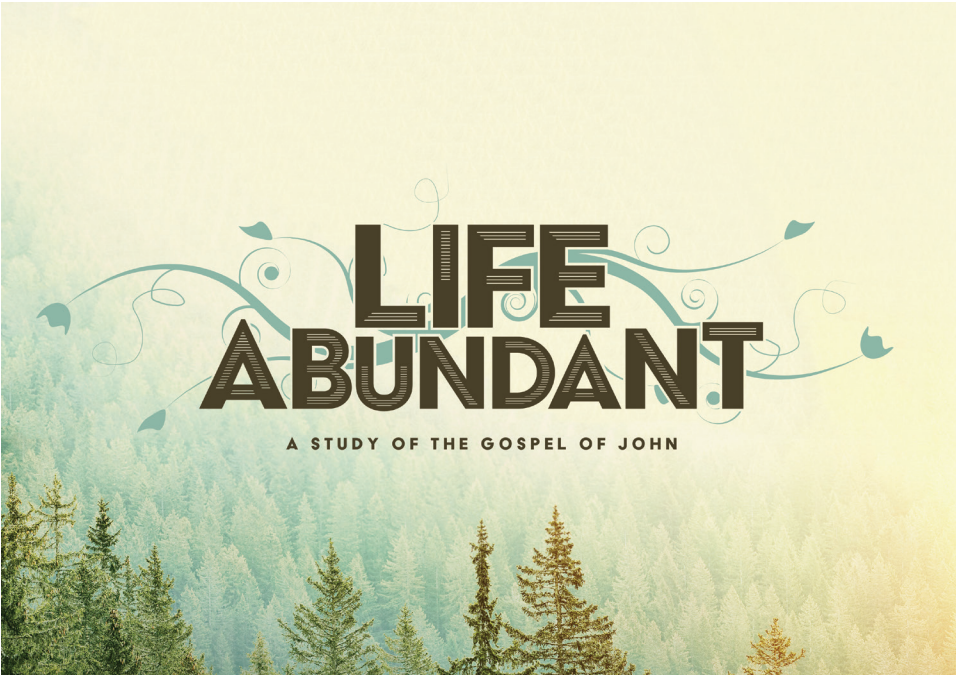
We have a group traveling together to Arlington for dinner and a baseball game on the evening of Friday, August 11. If you'd like to join us, please visit our table in the Main Hall today.
